- Volunteers Needed: drive Penske Truck, pull the band trailer (need a vehicle that can tow)

- Football Games: There are 5 regular schedule games. 5:30 PM meet at school, march pre-game, play throughout the game and half-time show. Pep Band will play at potential play-off games on a voluntary basis.

- Trip will include clinic at DePaul University, attendance at a symphony or Broadway show, Blue Man Group and a jazz club.
