- Outdoor vendors must bring their own canopy.
- No electricity is available for outdoor spaces.
- **No food trucks** — healthy food product vendors only (e.g., sourdough bread, cookies, snacks).
- Vendors provide their own signage and payment system.
- Setup window: **8:00–9:30 AM**; breakdown **after 5:00 PM (vendors may stay until 6:00 PM if they wish)**.

Part 2 • Vendor Agreement & Disclaimer

This agreement is between the vendor named above ("Vendor") and Community Wellness Collaboration, hosted by Jamilina ("Organizer"), for participation in the Community Wellness Collaboration Wellness Festival on August 22, 2026, at Plaza de Sueños, San Antonio, Texas (the "Event"). Please read each section before signing.

A. Fees, Cancellation & Refunds

- The booth **fee is \$45 per space**, due to this application by **August 16, 2026**, to reserve a space. Spaces are limited and assigned on a first-come basis.
- Applications are not confirmed until payment is received and the **Organizer approves the Vendor**.
- Cancellations made on or before **August 16, 2026**, may receive a refund, less any processing fees; cancellations after that date are non-refundable.
- If the Event is canceled by the Organizer for reasons within its control, fees will be refunded. The Event will proceed rain or shine; weather is not grounds for a refund.
- No-shows forfeit their fee and space.

B. Products, Permits & Compliance

- This festival accepts healthy food product vendors only (such as sourdough bread, cookies, and healthy snacks). No food trucks are permitted.
- Food product vendors are solely responsible for obtaining and maintaining all required City of San Antonio and Bexar County permits, cottage-food or food-handler certifications, and licenses that apply to their products.
- Vendors are responsible for safe food handling, proper labeling, and proper disposal of any waste and trash from their space.
- Vendors agree to comply with all applicable health, safety, and fire codes and with venue rules at Plaza de Sueños.

- Vendors will conduct themselves professionally and in keeping with the Event's community wellness mission.

- Wellness offerings are understood to complement, not replace, professional medical care; Vendors will not present products or services as medical advice, diagnosis, or treatment.
- The Organizer reserves the right to ask a Vendor to remove any product, signage, or claim deemed inappropriate, and to remove a Vendor for unsafe or disruptive conduct without refund.
- Vendors are responsible for their own sales, payment processing, and applicable sales tax collection and reporting.
