- Support in the Slack chat. Java experts promptly answer questions about Java theory and the tasks.
- Diploma of the course completion. At the end of the course, a student gets a diploma which is a "quality mark", according to IT recruiters.
- Employment. The CodeGym career center helps students create a CV and prepare for interviews. Also, CodeGym has partnered with large outsourcing companies to ensure employment for its students.

The new course caters to beginners or anyone with zero knowledge about programming; industry switchers looking for a career change; Java specialists seeking skills improvement or review material; innovators wishing to dive into the programming sphere while acquiring some fresh knowledge.
