A Resolution:

- WHEREAS: Nebraska Wesleyan University is an academic community dedicated to intellectual and personal growth within the context of a liberal arts education and in an environment of Christian concern; and,
- WHEREAS: The Student Affairs Senate is the formal governing body for students that creates legislation to improve student life; and,
- WHEREAS: The Pioneer/Johnson Complex, Centennial Hall, Plainsman Hall, and the Suites have common spaces with pool tables to promote community and resident engagement; and,
- WHEREAS: All four pool tables on campus are over ten years old and require a significant amount of repair each summer to maintain a usable condition; and,
- WHEREAS: The company that repairs and re-felts the pool tables has informed Residential Education that the tables are too old to re-felt and will not be able to be repaired this summer; and,
- WHEREAS: Residential Education does not have the funds to replace the pool tables.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE 2018-2019 STUDENT AFFAIRS SENATE THAT:

SAS allocates up to \$15,000 to Residential Education to purchase four pool tables for the residence halls.
