This step-by-step guide walks you through setting up your Apple and Google Developer accounts, allowing Radius to publish and manage your Client App on the App Store and Google Play Store.

Overview

This document provides a step-by-step guide to setting up your Apple and Google Developer accounts to enable Radius to publish and maintain your Client App on the App Store and Google Play Store.

Why Choose an Organization Account?

We strongly recommend enrolling as an Organization rather than an Individual, as Organization accounts allow for multiple users, including Radius, to assist in managing your app.

- **Individual Accounts:** If you are a sole proprietorship or one-person company, you must enroll as an individual. Apps are published under your personal name
- **Organization Accounts:** If your company is a corporation, limited liability company, or legal entity, you must enroll as an organization or your app will be rejected. Apps are published under the business name

 **Setting up your developer accounts as an Individual, some steps in this guide may vary.**

Important Notes

- Apple Developer enrollment requires an annual \$99 fee.
- Google Developer enrollment requires a one time only \$25 fee.
- Organizations must register for a D-U-N-S number before enrolling.

The D-U-N-S® Number Requirement

The following does not apply to Individual enrollments.

To enroll in the developer program, an organization is required to have a D-U-N-S number. This number is essential for verifying your business.

Request a D-U-N-S® Number

Requesting a D-U-N-S® Number

To enroll in Apple and Google Developer Programs as a business or organization, you must provide a D-U-N-S® (Data Universal Numbering System) number. This unique nine-digit identifier, issued by Dun & Bradstreet (D&B), verifies your business's legal identity.

Note: A D-U-N-S® number is not required for Sole Proprietors, DBAs, or Individual accounts.

Step 1: Check for an Existing D-U-N-S® Number

Before applying, check if your business already has a D-U-N-S® number:

1. Go to the [D-U-N-S® Number Lookup Tool](#)
2. Select "My Company" from the dropdown menu.
3. Enter your business details using one of the available search options.

If an existing D-U-N-S® number is found:

- Click "Email D-U-N-S Number" to receive the details.
- Enter your name and email to receive the information.

If no D-U-N-S® number is found:

- Click "Get a New D-U-N-S Number" to start the request process.
- Select "I have a U.S.-Based Business" and proceed with the application.

Step 2: Request a New D-U-N-S® Number

If your business does not have a D-U-N-S® Number, follow these steps:

1. Go to the [Dun & Bradstreet website](#)
2. Click “Get Started Now.”
3. Under “I have a U.S.-based business,” click “Get Started.”

Business Verification & Application Process:

4. Enter your business ZIP code & business name to search for an existing D-U-N-S® Number.
5. In the dropdown menu, select “I don’t see my business.”
6. Select the free membership package (paid options are unnecessary).
7. Create a MyD&B Account by entering your first and last name & email.
8. Click “Next” and check your inbox for a verification code.
9. Follow the instructions in the email to verify your account.
10. Once signed in, complete the D-U-N-S® Number Request form:

- ✓ Business website
- ✓ Business description code: 87420406
- ✓ Upload verification documents (e.g., business license or incorporation documents).

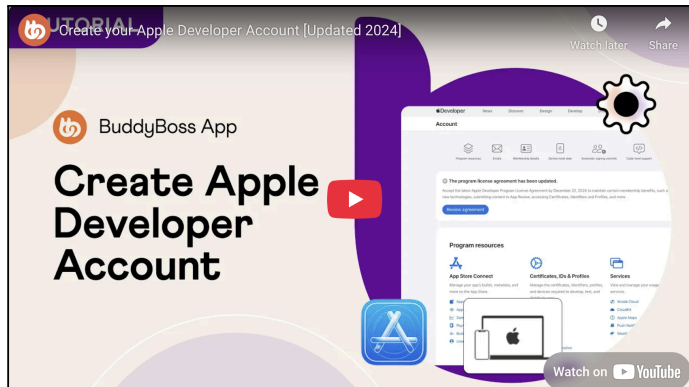
11. Click “Submit” to complete your application.

After submitting your request and providing the necessary documentation, you should receive your D-U-N-S Number within 3–5 business days. If you haven’t received it after 2 weeks, please contact D-U-N-S Support via email.

Once your account has been verified, Apple will send an email with instructions on how to complete your enrollment.

Step 8: Complete Enrollment

1. Sign into your [Apple Store Connect Dashboard](#).
2. Click to Review the License agreement at the top.

6. Review the legal agreement.
 - a. Check the box to agree to the terms and conditions and are of legal age.
 - b. Click **“Continue”** to proceed.

Step 9: Complete Membership Purchase

1. Check the box to Enable Automatic Renewal (optional)

IMPORTANT: If not enabled, set a yearly reminder to renew manually, as your app will be removed from the App Store within 24 hours of expiration to avoid any disruption.

2. Enter your credit card information.

(Apple does not accept PayPal or other payment methods)

3. Click **“Continue to Review”**
4. Click **“Place Your Order”** in the next window to complete the purchase.

NOTE: Payment processing may take up to 48 hours. During this time, your dashboard may still display a message prompting you to make a payment—please disregard it.

Additionally, you will not be able to send out the invite to Radius until the payment has been fully processed.

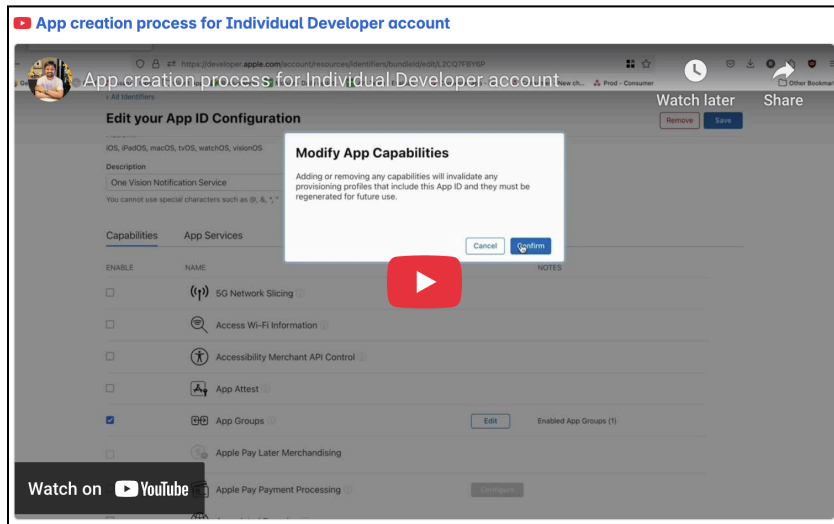

Step 1: Creating a Certificate

1. Log into the [Apple Developer Account](#).
2. Navigate to [Certificates](#)
3. Click **+** (near Certificates.)
4. Select **Apple Distribution** under "Software" and click **Continue**.
5. Under **Create a New Certificate**, click "Choose File" and upload the **CertificateSigningRequest.certSigningRequest** file.
6. Click **Continue** and **download**, and **save** the certificate file.

Step 2: Creating a Group ID

1. Navigate to [Identifiers](#), click **+**.
2. Select **App Groups**, enter provided details (description and identifier).
3. Click **Continue**, then **Register**.

Step 3: Creating App IDs

3.1 App ID

1. Navigate to [Identifiers](#), click **+**.
2. Under “Register a New Identifier” select **App IDs**, click **Continue**.
3. Type **App** and click **Continue**
4. Fill in the details provided:
 - a. Explicit / Wildcard – Select **Explicit** if not selected.
 - b. Description – **App ID Description**
 - c. Bundle ID – **App ID Bundle ID**
5. Under **Capabilities**, check the following options:
 - a. App Groups
 - b. Associated Domains
 - c. Push Notifications
 - d. Sign In with Apple
7. Click **Continue**, then **Register**.
8. From the list of Identifiers, select the **App ID** that you have just created.
9. Under **Capabilities** → **App Groups** → Select **Configure**.
10. Select previously created Group ID, click **Continue**
11. Click Save, and then click on “**Confirm**” on the “**Modify App Capabilities**” alert.

3.2 Notification Service App ID

1. Navigate to [Identifiers](#), click **+**.
2. Under “Register a New Identifier” select **App IDs**, click **Continue**.
3. Type **App** and click **Continue**
4. Fill in the details provided:
 - a. Explicit / Wildcard – Select **Explicit** if not selected.
 - b. Description – **Notification Service App ID : Description**
 - c. Bundle ID – **Notification Service App ID: Bundle ID**
5. Under **Capabilities**, select:
 - a. **App Groups**
6. Click **Continue**, then **Register** on the next screen.

7. From the list of Identifiers, select the Notification Service ID that you have just created (`com.radiusagent.xxxxxxxx.notification`)
8. Under **Capabilities** → **App Groups** → Select **Configure**.
 - a. Select the **Group ID** that was created earlier and click **Continue**.
9. Click on Save, and then click on “**Confirm**” on the “**Modify App Capabilities**” alert.

Step 4: Creating Provisioning Profiles

4.1 App Provisioning Profile

1. Navigate to [Profiles](#), click +.
2. Under **Distribution**, select **App Store Connect**
3. There will be 2 IDs (Which you have created in the previous steps) in the list, and first select the **App ID (com.radiusagent.xxxxxxxx)** and Click **continue**.
4. Under **Select Certificate**, Select the created certificate and Click **Continue**.
5. For the Provisioning Profile Name, fill in the details that we have provided:
 - a. <APP NAME> App (*From the details we have provided: App Provisioning Profile → Provisioning Profile Name*)
6. Click on **Download** and a file will get downloaded.

4.2 Notification Service Provisioning Profile

1. Navigate to [Profiles](#), click +.
2. Under **Distribution**, select **App Store Connect**
3. There will be 2 IDs (Which you have created in the previous steps) in the list, and select the Notification App Service ID (looks like: `com.radiusagent.xxxxxxxx.notification`) and click **Continue**.
4. Under **Select Certificate**, Select the created certificate and click on **Continue**.
5. For the Provisioning Profile Name, fill in the details that we have provided:
 - a. <APP NAME> Notification App (*From the details we have provided: Notification App Provisioning Profile → Provisioning Profile Name*)
6. Click on **Download** and a file will get downloaded.

Step 5: Key

1. Navigate to [Keys](#), click +.

2. Enter the given details in the form:
 - a. Key Name: **Radius Key**
3. Select the below services:
 - a. **Apple Push Notification service (APNs)** and Click on Configure.
 - i. In the Environment: Select “Sandbox & Production”
 - ii. Key Restriction: Team Scoped (All Topics), and click on “Save”
 - b. **Sign in with Apple:**
 - i. In the Primary App ID list, select the App ID we have created, and click on “Save”
4. Click on **Continue**, and then click **Register**
5. Note down the Key ID, and click on “**Download**”.

Final Step: Email the Downloaded Files

Once the app creation and ID creations are completed, reply to the email with the Key ID and 4 downloaded files back or email us with
