| Cost for Non-members: | Cost of round with no prize fund (\$80 greens fees +tax) |
| Whom to Pay: | Matt Helton Entrants pay the prize fund to SCGL, not the golf course (\$10) Methods of payment: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Venmo payments can be made to '@Matthew-H-11.'• Cash can be given to Matt Helton• Checks must be made out to 'Space Club Golf League' and can be given to Matt Helton in person |
| When to Pay: | Deadline is June 21 st ; please contact Matt Helton (matthew.d.helton@boeing.com) if an exception needs to be made |
| Format: | Stroke play: there will be two flights, with prize winners in each flight. |

Rule clarifications:

- **Summer rules apply**; play the ball as it lies at all times unless your ball is in a fairway divot (6 inches of relief in that scenario); NO relief from non-fairway divots
- Standard OB rules apply: if you hit your tee shot beyond white stakes, you must re-hit from the original location with a 1-stroke penalty (i.e. if you hit OOB on your tee shot, you must re-hit and you will be laying 3 from that spot)
- Lost balls that are hit into areas that are not marked with white, red or yellow stakes (i.e. bushes, trees, fescue, etc.) can be played as a lateral penalty
- If you hit your ball into an area that contains OB, but you think the ball was lost before it reached, please consult with your playing partners and make an honest calculation of where the ball was lost

Tees:

2 options:

- White tees (6045 yards, 70.0/127)
- Gold tees (5607 yards, 68.2/120)

The purpose of the multi-tee option is to allow players to select the tees that best fit their distance. **The spirit of the rule is NOT to select a shorter tee because you think you can score better against the handicap system.**

If you play the shorter tee, your course handicap will be reduced. For instance, if you are a 8.3 index over 18 holes, your course handicap would be 7 from the white tees; from the gold tees your course handicap would be 5; so in that example you lose 2 shots against the field by playing the shorter tee.

If you play the shorter tees and want to be eligible for KPs (1 on each 9) and LD you MUST move back to the white tee for those 3 holes. You will not get a handicap adjustment. You have the option of playing from the gold tee, but you will not be eligible for KP/LD prizes.

2. Prizes:

There are two flights of players, based on handicap. Each flight will receive its own payouts for the same set of prizes.

The dollar payouts listed here are only approximate and are based on the attendance figures from recent field days.

Ties are broken by awarding prizes to the player who had the best net score on the #1 handicap hole; if both players made the same net score, we will go to the #2 handicap hole and so on until there is a winner.

NOTE: This year there is no restriction on multiple prizes; if you win a low net prize and have the longest drive and a KP, you can collect all (per the league vote).
