



6-Day Mount Elgon Trek & Pian Upe Wildlife Safari (Uganda)

Difficulty: Challenging

Accommodation: Apoka Safari Lodge / Wilderness Camps

Success Rate: ~80%

This 6-day adventure combines an exhilarating trek to Mount Elgon's Wagagai Peak (4,321m) with an unforgettable safari in Pian Upe Wildlife Reserve, one of Uganda's most pristine and lesser-explored parks. You'll experience high-altitude trekking, stunning landscapes, crater explorations, and a wildlife safari featuring cheetahs, zebras, and giraffes.

Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive in Mbale, Transfer to Mount Elgon

- Arrive in **Mbale**, the starting point for your Mount Elgon trek.
- Meet your trekking guides and rangers for a briefing session.
- Transfer to the park entrance and check into your mountain lodge or campsite.
- Explore the nearby Sipi Falls, famous for scenic waterfalls and abseiling.
- Enjoy a relaxed evening in the foothills of Mount Elgon.

Travel Time: ~5 hours from Kampala to Mbale.

Accommodation: Sipi River Lodge / Rafiki Lodge / Mountain Campsite.

Meals: Lunch & dinner.

Day 2: Hike to Mude Camp (3,500m)

- Begin your trek from Budadiri Gate, following the Sasa Trail, known for its steep and challenging ascent.
- Hike through tropical rainforests, bamboo zones, and moorlands.
- Cross the Jackson Pool and Jackson's Table, a flat resting area offering breathtaking views.
- Arrive at Mude Cave Camp (3,500m) for an overnight stay in mountain tents.

Hiking Time: ~7-8 hours.

Scenery: Rainforests, bamboo zones, and alpine meadows.

Accommodation: Mude Cave Camp (Basic mountain shelters/tents).

Meals: Breakfast, lunch & dinner.

Day 3: Summit Wagagai Peak (4,321m) & Explore the Crater

- **Summit Day!** Early morning ascent to **Wagagai Peak (4,321m)**, Mount Elgon's highest point.
- Enjoy breathtaking views of Uganda & Kenya, with vast calderas and unique flora.
- Explore Mount Elgon's Crater, the world's largest volcanic caldera.
- Descend back to **Mude Camp** for overnight rest.

Hiking Time: ~8-10 hours round trip.

Highlights: Wagagai Peak, breathtaking crater views.

Accommodation: Mude Cave Camp (Basic mountain shelters/tents).

Meals: Breakfast, lunch & dinner.

Day 4: Descend & Transfer to Pian Upe Wildlife Reserve

- Trek down from Mude Camp to Budadiri, completing your Mount Elgon trek.
- Have lunch in **Mbale** before transferring to **Pian Upe Wildlife Reserve**.
- Check into a wilderness safari lodge or tented camp near the reserve.
- Relax with **stunning sunset views** over Uganda's savannah plains.

Travel Time: ~3-4 hours from Mount Elgon to Pian Upe.

Accommodation: Apoka Safari Lodge / Wilderness Camp.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch & dinner.

Day 5: Game Drive in Pian Upe to See Cheetahs, Zebras & Giraffes

- Wake up for an early morning game drive in Pian Upe Wildlife Reserve.
- Spot cheetahs, zebras, giraffes, elands, oribis, buffaloes, and hyenas.

- Enjoy **spectacular landscapes** with rolling plains and acacia woodlands.
- Visit hot springs and rocky outcrops within the reserve.
- Relax at the lodge or take an optional guided nature walk.

Wildlife to See: Cheetahs, giraffes, zebras, buffaloes, hyenas, oribis.

Accommodation: Apoka Safari Lodge / Wilderness Camp.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch & dinner.

Day 6: Return to Kampala

- After breakfast, enjoy a scenic drive back to Kampala or Entebbe Airport for your departure.
- Optional **stop** at the **Source** of the **Nile** in **Jinja** for sightseeing or a boat ride.

Travel Time: ~7-8 hours back to Kampala.

Meals: Breakfast & lunch.
