Montpelier Hills New Once-a-Week Collection Days

- MH North (Apache Tears and nearby streets)
 - Tuesdays
 - Regular Trash/Garbage in wheeled container with secured lid ("Toter")
 - Recycle in wheeled container with secured lid ("Toter") marked "Recycle" or "X"
 - Mondays
 - Yard Waste: Clippings, Leaves, branches, Christmas Trees without decoration
- MH South (Tuscany/Hermosa and nearby streets)
 - Fridays
 - Regular Trash/Garbage in wheeled container with secured lid ("Toter")
 - Recycle in wheeled container with secured lid ("Toter") marked "Recycle" or "X"
 - Mondays
 - Yard Waste: Clippings, Leaves, branches, Christmas Trees without decoration

New Rolling Toter/Cart Information,

"At no additional cost, all residents receiving County-contracted trash and recycling collection services will receive one, wheeled 64-gallon toter/cart with tight-fitting lid is designed to keep your trash secure and animals out, Delivery of the toter/carts will begin June 2016 and is expected to last through the end of the year" click here for video

MH HoA REGULATION #18: (see latest version) TRASH/MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

1. Trash or recycling containers may not be placed outside before 6:00p.m. the night prior to pick-up. Refuse containers must be collected the same day of the pick-up and located out of sight either indoors or behind approved fences or partitions. Containers left in front of the house for more than one day will be collected and discarded. Trash from bags that are ripped open by animals, vandals, etc. shall be picked-up by the owner the day of pick-up.

*EFFECTIVE July 1, 2015: Plastic bags of any color, size or shape, and plastic film WILL NO LONGER be accepted in the Prince George's County Residential Curbside Single-Stream Recycling Program.

To ensure pick-up, put trash, recycle or yard waste out by **6:00 am** on trash day; no earlier than 5 pm the night before. MHHA asks you to retrieve trash cans by 5 pm on trash day and that you retrieve trash bags/cans that weren't picked-up until the next trash day. Please pick up strewn trash litter in your area.

The county has until 8 pm to pick up Refuse or Recycle or Yard Waste on any route (regardless of your normal trash pick-up time). So they do not consider it a pick-up failure until after 8 pm. They generally will NOT come the next day to pick up trash that wasn't picked up on scheduled trash days. They MAY send an inspector, who will leave a brochure and a reminder to have trash out by 6:00 am (the earliest possible pick-up time on all routes).

Prince George's County 2017 Holiday Trash/Recycle/Yard collection schedules

P.G. County will pick up Yard Waste from April 15th through January 15th *only*, which includes Christmas trees.

Hazardous waste (paint, motor oil, antifreeze, tires, computers, etc.) is not picked up. It can be disposed of free at the Brown Station landfill hazardous waste collection facility on Sundays 11:00 am - 3:00 pm MAP Prince George's County residents may dispose of trash, *free of charge*, every Sunday at Browns Station landfill, 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. (until 6:00 p.m. from first Sunday in April to last Sunday in October). (Brown Station landfill info may be outdated)
