<u>Instructions</u>

- 1. **Make a copy of this document** and keep it somewhere safe. It lists all the possible question types, and shows you how to format your questions.
- Use the template on page 2 to write the questions you want to be exported to your typeform.
- 3. **Every question must start with the question type in square brackets**. This lets us know which question type to create. For example:

{Email} What's your email?

4. **Multiple Choice, Dropdown, and Ranking questions:** Use indented, lettered bullets to list the possible choices. Example:

{Multiple Choice} What's your favorite animal?

- a. Cat
- b. Hippo
- c. Giraffe
- d. Other
- 5. **Opinion Scale and Rating**: The scale starts at 1 by default. Choose a number from 5 to 10 (for Opinion Scale), or 1 to 10 (for Rating) to set the number of steps in the scale. Put this number in curly braces. For example:

{Opinion Scale} {7} How likely are you to recommend us to a friend or colleague?

6. Changing the font and color of text in this document won't affect the text in your typeform. You can change that in your typeform's *Design* settings.
