



Northwood-Oregonian Volunteer Corps And Clay Recycling Volunteer Project

A bill to create an expandable recycling team
to service select Clay High School classrooms due to
the lack of a state provided recycling pickup as well
as an organized system to further expand future
volunteer teams and volunteer projects

- 1 Creates the Northwood-Oregonian Volunteer Corps (“Volunteer Corps”) which shall be the
- 2 Umbrella organization for future programs administered by volunteers. These Volunteer Corps
- 3 Shall be headed by a Director that shall be appointed by Parliament. The Director shall have
- 4 The authority to appoint and dismiss Project Heads at will. Project Heads shall be in charge of
- 5 Any projects administered by volunteers created by the Northwood-Oregonian Parliament
- 6 Relinquished to the Volunteer Corps. These projects shall be, in this and future bills, marked or
- 7 Denoted as a “Volunteer Project”. Project Heads of these Volunteer Projects shall have the duty of
- 8 Fulfilling the goals and conditions of their Volunteer Project as outlined by the Parliament as well
- 9 As the authority to recruit citizens of the Kingdom to participate in the project as well as dismiss
- 10 Non-participating or otherwise unruly participants. Volunteer Projects shall only be created and
- 11 Dissolved by the Northwood-Oregonian Parliament. Denotes that the first Director of the
- 12 Volunteer Corps shall be Carson Snyder.
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- 14 Creates the Clay Recycling Volunteer Project with the goal of providing a slow test rollout of
- 15 Recycling services to classrooms at Clay High School. The project shall start in the classrooms of
- 16 Mr. Sneed, Mr. Dorner, Mr. Bruns, and Mr. Cooney. Should all the teachers of these classrooms
- 17 Decline the program being brought to their room the Project Head shall be in charge of finding
- 18 At least two new classrooms to bring the program to. The Project Head shall be in charge of
- 19 Acquiring containers to place in these classrooms to collect recycling. The Project Head shall
- 20 Further be in charge of following all proper recycling protocols and transporting collected
- 21 Recycling to proper drop off points or other locations in which the recycling will be picked up.
- 22 The Project Head shall also be in charge of properly making the users of the classroom aware of
- 23 The program.
