

Year End Cafeteria Balance Information

You can check your child's balance at any time on line at www.myschoolbucks.com. Balances can also be found in PowerSchool, but please note that cafeteria information on PowerSchool may be up to 24 hours behind.

All account IOUs must be repaid by the last day of school.

K-11 students

After the last day of school, your child's positive account balance will be held by the district and carried over to next year. If your child is moving to a different school building within the State College Area School District, the balance will be automatically transferred to the appropriate building.

If your child will not be attending a SCASD school in the fall, follow the link at the bottom of the page to tell us how to handle your child's balance.

Graduating Seniors

Lunch Balance Donations

This fund is used to repay IOUs, to support families who need help but are not eligible for free school meals, and to provide extra lunch money to older, free-eligible students who can use some extra food with their meals. Payment can also be made by check and should be mailed to: SCASD FSD, 653 Westerly Parkway, State College, PA 16801. Please include the name of the student(s) for whom the check is intended, the school(s) they attend, and a phone number in case of questions. Make checks payable to SCASD FSD. Middle and High School students are welcome to submit a cash or check payment directly to any cashier in their school cafeteria.
