## **Terms and Conditions - Youth Participation**

### Sport Competition

All players engage in the team-based sport of T4 Bouldering - more specifically the T4 Everyday format (T4E).

### Teams:

Players are encouraged to join a team with their friends.

Players are aligned to their team in the registration process.

However, if a player does not have a specific team to join then they are allocated a position in a POOL. Players may transition out of a POOL where applicable. Please note that players in the POOL are not eligible for representative pathway events.

Players must compete with their team on their team-allocated Sport day session time. This includes players in a POOL.

### Registration

Registration is complete upon payment.

Players register individually either online or at the front desk at the start of each season.

If a player has previously played in a previous season and arrives to play in a new season then the player is automatically invoiced for that season.

### Supervision:

There is supervision onsite 10 minutes before and after session times. Please drop off and pick up within this timeframe.

Primary school players are required to have a parent or guardian on site for the duration of their sport time.

### Participant Areas:

Players are to be upstairs during their session. The allocated waiting area is on the grey seats on the eastern side of the facility. Players are to wait here for their session to commence, or to be collected by a parent or guardian as per our Safe Child Policy..

### Session Times:

Once registered, players are committed to this time slot for the duration of the season.

Teams may only change session times if authorised by a staff member.

Training sessions are for High School players and are divided into age and access categories. Sport and Training times are as per the online calendar.

### Shoes:

Bouldering shoes are compulsory.

Supply your own or use hire shoes. Socks must be worn with hire shoes.

Shoes must be worn at all times in the facility. No bare/socked feet.

### Credit:

Credit is generically not offered for missed sessions or events. Exceptional circumstances may apply upon application.

#### Player Code of Conduct

Players are expected to maintain our fair play code of conduct as per the T4 Code of Conduct and Participation Standards.

#### Parent / Guardian Code of Conduct

Respectful behaviour for all players, spectators and guests and are also expected to follow the cultural rules and expectations of our sport.

At least one parent or guardian of primary-aged youth are required to remain on-site at all times when sport is on. Staff members are not expected to undertake parenting roles.
