



DISH COMPETITION - GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

These terms and conditions are intended to ensure that the Dietary Shifts (DISH) Competition ("Competition") is organized fairly and responsibly in both Indonesia and Kenya. Please read the below Terms and Conditions ("T&C") carefully before agreeing to participate in any capacity in this competition. By registering to the Competition you confirm that you have read, understood and agreed without reservations to these T&C.

GAIN as the lead organizer ("Organizer") of the Competition reserves the right to amend the terms and conditions. Any and all amendments will be posted on the event microsite.

Eligibility:

- Lead applicant must be registered as an agency or organization or institution or be a citizen of Kenya or Indonesia only; applying in their own country chapter of the DISH Challenge.
- The Lead applicant identified as the team leader at the application stage must be 18 years of age on the date of applying for the Competition.
- Employees, Vendors, Agencies working with GAIN, EAT, FOLU, Nutrition Connect between June 2024 to June 2025, as well as their immediate family members and others with direct conflict of interest, and others if deemed unsuitable, are not eligible to participate in the competition.

2. Entry Requirements:

- Participants must submit their solutions via the online Google form only ([See the 'Apply' link on website](#)) by the deadline of 31 October 2024.
- Each solution must comply with the competition's overall theme of promoting dietary shifts towards healthier and sustainable dietary choices.
- Each solution must only identify with ONE of the 5 categories specified for competing. (For more details see [competition website](#))

3. Stage of Readiness of the Solution Being Submitted :

- We welcome solutions from the Proof of Concept stage to fully operational growth stage projects with individuals /organizations. Idea stage submissions will not be entertained.
- For submissions of the solutions, applicants should exhibit prowess as specified in the Evaluation Criteria specified on the [competition website](#).



Content Guidelines:

Entries must be original and should not infringe upon any third-party rights. All sources and references must be properly quoted and identified.

- Entries must not contain any offensive, defamatory, or discriminatory content.
- Entries must ensure that they are aligned with local dietary customs and

sensitivities in Indonesia/ Kenya, as the case may be.

- Entries must not contain any marketing information for promotion purposes such that it is intended for advertising purposes or is trying to sell or promote any goods and services to consumers or others.

5. Benefits for participation and finalists:

- This Competition is intended to select the top 15 entries in the competition's thematic areas in each country Kenya and Indonesia.
- The Competition offers USD 1000 to the 15 finalists in each country. The full details of all benefits of participation are as detailed on the [competition website](#).
- The media coverage and benefits of the competition extend only to the main lead applicant of each application submitted (especially in case of team pitches), and the solution/ proposal being pitched.
- The benefits of participation and winning the competition are non-transferable and must be accepted by the applicant identified as the individual applicant or Team Leader (In case of a team) .
- In-person attendance of a winner is mandated for the Finale` event to be held in presence of media and dignitaries. Travel of the individual winner who is only the identified Team Leader, will be financially supported by the DISH Competition organizing team from anywhere within Kenya to the location identified in Nairobi ; and for Indonesian participants, from anywhere within Indonesia to the location identified in Jakarta.

6. Judging Criteria:

- Entries will be judged based on the evaluation criteria detailed on the [competition website](#).
- The decision of the judges at each stage of the competition is final and binding.

7. Notification of Finalists:

- Shortlisted applicants and finalists will be notified via email/phone within a reasonable time after the judging process is completed.
- The finalists may be required to sign and return an affidavit of eligibility and liability release.

8. Publicity:

- By entering the Competition, participants grant the Organisers and other partners involved in the project, the right to publicize their names and submitted materials for promotional purposes without additional compensation or benefits.

9. Modification or Cancellation:



The Organizers reserve the right to modify, suspend, or cancel the Competition or any of the phases, in the event of unforeseen circumstances or force majeure, at any point of time as may be necessary.

The Organizers reserve the right to disqualify any applicant and their entry submitted at any stage of the competition or thereafter, for any reason that it deems appropriate, including if found in breach of any of the terms and conditions of the competition.

10. Compliance with Laws:

- Participants must comply with all applicable laws and regulations in their country of residence i.e Kenya or Indonesia.

11. Collection of Personal Data

- In the context of the Competition, the Organizer will have access and collect some personal data to facilitate monitoring and evaluation of the submissions; to publicize the competition and its thematic areas pertaining to dietary shifts in Kenya and Indonesia and to publicize the solutions that are shortlisted through the various judging rounds **In the context of the Competition, the Organizer will have access and collect some personal data to publicize the competition and its thematic areas pertaining to dietary shifts Kenya and Indonesia and the solutions that are proposed by way of the participating solution in by applicants to the DISH competition** (the “Purpose”). By signing the T&C you authorize the Organizer to process the personal data for the Purpose, including transferring it to the partners involved in the project.
