When signing up for conference times, please keep in mind that conferences for grades K-4 last 15 minutes, whereas grades 5-8 last 10 minutes. Parents with children who work with Mrs. Vande Weerd are encouraged to set up conference times with her to discuss progress. Conferences for grades K-4 will be held in their individual homerooms, whereas conferences for grades 5-8 will be held in the gym. Conferences with Mrs. Schreur will be held in Room 204 (band room) and conferences with Mrs. Vande Weerd will be held in Room 122 (Academic Assistance Room) If you do not sign up for a time, a conference time will be given to parents with kids in K-8th grade. Preschool parents are not required to have Fall Conferences but may request one, if there is a need. Please sign up for your conferences by Friday, November 1. Report Cards: Report Cards for grades 1-8 and progress reports for PK and Kindergarten will be emailed to parents tomorrow. Please make sure to watch for these and let the office or teachers know if you did not receive them. Just a few bits of information to help with understanding how attendance works on JMC:

Absent Unexcused: Student gone without parent informing the school

Absent Excused: Student gone with parent informing the school

Tardy Unexcused: Students are late getting to class on time (ex. messing around in the bathroom, not showing up to school by 8:25am, etc.)

Tardy Excused: Students are gone from school for a short period of time (ex. doctor appt., ortho, etc.)

Students in Grades 4-8 will also be coming home with a manila envelope that has report card related information for parents to look at with their children. Please ask your 4th-8th grader for this envelope. There is some material that needs to be signed and returned. This item should be returned at Parent-Teacher Conferences.


