Dress Code:

A student's dress while on campus must not disrupt the operations or learning environment. When considering clothing options, students should ask themselves how their choices may impact the positive learning environment we enjoy at Riverside Brookfield High School. Students who are not in compliance with our dress code policy will be sent to the Dean's Office where an administrator will contact the family.

Dress Code:

Students can wear the following:

- Hats facing straight forward or straight backward.
- Hats must allow the face to be visible to staff
- Religious headwear
- Headwear including but not limited to headscarves and bandanas
- Hoodie sweatshirts (face must be visible to the school staff)
 - Hoods may not be worn in classrooms
- Footwear is required at all times to comply with Health Code regulations.

Electronic Policy:

Electronic devices **are not** permitted on any student's person from the beginning of the student's first class of the day until dismissal from the student's last class of the day unless prior permission has been given by a staff member. Please find the electronic policy [here](#).

- All technology, such as cell phones, ear pods, watches, electronic tablets, or other electronic devices brought by a student into any learning environment must be placed in the 'off' position and out of normal sight, prior to crossing the threshold of that venue, unless prior approval has been given by the teacher, coach, or sponsor.
- Students needing to make a phone call while at school, must request to use the phone in the Main Office. Students using their cell phones to place a call during school hours will be escorted to the Dean's Office, where an administrator will contact the family.
