

Neon AI OS Skills — for the Mycroft Mark II

Neon uses sounds, lights and words to let you know that it is listening, but there is no need to wait for it to acknowledge you.

Start each Neon command and skill by saying **"Hey Neon"** and then say the command without pause. For example, say **"Hey Neon play Jazz."**

You can also press the round button on top of your Mark II in order to alert Neon to listen.

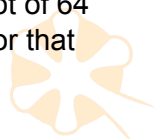

Wireless Audio Streaming

Play audio on your Mark 2 via Airplay, Bluetooth, Spotify, or KDE Connect.

All services are enabled by default, and can be turned on or off by saying:

Disable / Deactivate *service name*

Enable / Activate *service name*

Is *service name* enabled?

Bluetooth

Open up Bluetooth on your device.

Say "Hey Neon, pair Bluetooth".

Select "neon" from the available connections on your device.

Pairing is auto-approved within 60 seconds.

KDE Connect

Open KDE Connect on your phone, laptop, or other device.

Say, "Hey Neon, pair KDE Connect"

Pairing is auto-approved within 30 seconds.

AirPlay

On Mac: Click sound icon in the menu bar > select "uxplay@neon".

On iPhone/iPad: Swipe down > select Airplay icon > choose "uxplay@neon."

Rename it by saying "Hey Neon, rename airplay device."

Spotify

Requires Spotify Premium.

In Spotify, go to Settings > "Connect to a Device" > select "Neon Mark II."

Rename it by saying "Hey Neon, rename Spotify device."

Specialized Skills

Home Assistant  - Skill to interface with Home Assistant (<https://www.home-assistant.io/>)

Access this skill either by:

- Saying "Hey Neon, open Home Assistant dashboard"
- Tapping the bottom of the screen on your Mark II for a menu of programs and selecting HA

Next, enter your Home Assistant URL (for example ws://192.168.1.10 or

wss://homeassistant.mydomain.com) and generate a QR code to sign in using a phone or tablet.

Touch Screen

Wallpaper

Swipe left in the middle of the screen for a new home screen wallpaper.

Or change it in the system menu:

Swipe down for the menu, choose Settings → Display → Wallpaper Settings

System Menu

Swipe down for a system menu.

Please consider the submenus "under construction", as some settings will not apply to Neon on the Mark II.
