SD350 Questions - To be Submitted to All Candidates

1. What environmental issue(s) are you most concerned about in the city of San Diego?
Which environmental issues will be a priority for your office?
2. How satisfied are you with the progress the city has made on its Climate Action Plan and how will you ensure its legally binding goals are met? Specifically, what would you do to reduce carbon emissions?
3. How would you like to expand public transportation in your district and throughout the city? What are some potential extension routes of the San Diego Trolley that you would like the city to work with SANDAG to facilitate?
4. Our local utility has fought rooftop solar for years. What will you do to support the use of rooftop solar and increased energy efficiency retrofitting of homes and buildings?
5. How will you ensure the watersheds in your district are healthier when you leave office? What steps would you like to take to reduce the levels of toxins that flow from yards into our watersheds, onto our beaches and into the sea?
6. What is your stance regarding the IPCC report released on April 5th, that detailed that we only have until 2030 to make substantial improvements to stop climate change, and how will you use your position to help the climate?
7. Building electrification is a key strategy for reducing GHG emissions. Do you support an all-electric reach code for new residential and commercial buildings in the city? Do you support funding a just transition for impacted workers as the region electrifies its existing buildings?
8. Is Chula vista selling any land property to Amazon?
9. Is Chula vista going to use some of that money and invest it back into the community?
