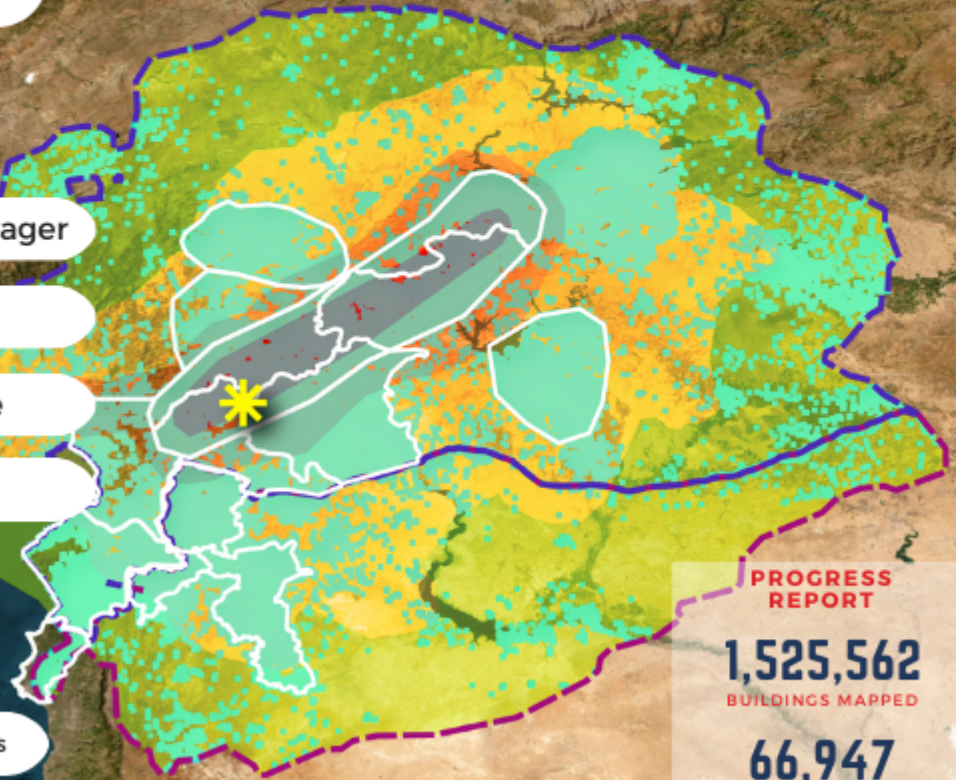

For every mapped/validated building, POI, road, TM task completed, the OMHAP will donate a dedicated amount to a humanitarian NGO working for the Syria and Turkey Earthquake.

Support Swags

Dedicated mappers and validators in the activation mapping will receive a swag pack for their dedication and support.

1. **Map for a Cause** - For each well-mapped and validated building, road, POI, task completed will be an equivalent amount of donation by the Open Mapping Hub Asia Pacific on behalf of the OSM mapper/organization to a selected humanitarian organization doing on-the-ground help in affected areas in Syria and Turkey. The following table shows the breakdown of activity per donation:

Activity
150 buildings mapped via HOT Tasking Manager
50 points of interest via MapRoulette
50 km of roads via HOT Tasking Manager
20 tasks completely mapped via HOT Tasking Manager
10 tasks completely validated via HOT Tasking Manager

We deeply encourage the use of the hashtag [#SMforST2023](#) as we would be pulling out the results using this. All mappers that have added the [#SMforST2023](#) and have contributed will receive a certificate of donation containing the total amount incurred and the overall statistics in the campaign.

2. Swags for Mappers - Swags will also be coordinated for exceptional mappers who have contributed to the project. The AP Hub will coordinate with local OSM communities to get this delivered to the identified mappers. Note: Only one swag pack per OSM account and only available for [Asia Pacific Hub Priority Countries](#).
