Step 1:

Create the word on the provided index card that will be go on the wall. *Make sure the word is large, easily readable, and spelled correctly.* Feel free to decorate your word as you choose (if your word has a visual or symbol to go with it, this would be a good place to include it!).

Step 2:

Record a video of yourself explaining and demonstrating (if applicable) your term. Keep it brief but understandable so that a 6th Grader would get it. Email it to yourself or save it into your Google Drive. You'll have to download it from your email or Drive to your H Drive. You'll also need to take a picture of your word, email it to yourself (or save it to your google drive) and upload it to your H Drive.

Step 3:

Check your email for your BlippAR invite if you haven't yet. If you don't have an invite yet, come see me after creating and sending your videos to yourself so an invite can be sent. Create your account using your school password.

After accepting the project invitation sent to your school email go through the following steps:

- 1. Sign in at accounts.blippar.com
- 2. Click our 2019-2020 project and create a blip.
- 3. Name your Blip whatever your term is.
- 4. Upload the picture of your card as your "marker."
- 5. Your image will appear in the workstation.
- 6. Click and drag the "video" button on the left over top of your image.
- 7. On the right hand side, click the option to upload your video.
- 8. Go to "preview," open the Blippar app on your device, enter the *campaign code* in the settings and click "test to publish." Scan with your device. If it your video and button for the website definition appear you're all set!

Stay within the Word Wall project!

Do not open or alter anybody else's word or uploads in any way!
