JPIIHS Winter Dance 2024 Guest Dress Code

John Paul II High School, a Catholic high school, has high expectations of how our students dress. With that in mind, the following dress code expectations will be enforced at all JPIIHS dances. The Winter dance is an annual event with the theme decided by the junior class. The clothing worn at this dance should not detract from the theme of the evening. Here is a link to the full dress code policy: <u>2024 Winter Dance Dress Code</u>

Expectations of Ladies:

- Dresses/tops must have a front that falls at or above the front bra line and must not show cleavage
- The back of the dress/top must fall at or above the mid-back area (no lower than the bottom of the rib cage)
- Cutouts from the back of the dress/top must not extend beyond the side of the body to expose midriff
- Dress/skirt length must be mid-thigh or longer. This also applies to slits in dresses. Dresses must be of appropriate length even if leggings or sheer layers are added underneath the dress.
- Dresses/tops must not be see-through, and any sheer or mesh overlays, tears, or cutouts must not expose any area that should be covered (including, but not limited to, midriff and sides of torso)
- Dresses/tops/skirts must not be extremely fitted with the purpose of outlining the body silhouette or so fitted that they gather/rise when you walk
- Jeans must be free from rips/tears/holes
- Visible tattoos or piercings (other than earrings) should not be worn or shown
- Nice, clean dress shoes are expected (no flip flops, Vibrams, Crocs, Birkenstocks, slippers, etc.)
- Cowboy boots and hats acceptable
- Avoid wearing anything that detracts from the theme of the evening

Expectations of Gentlemen:

- Dress pants/slacks or jeans free from rips/tears/holes
- Dress shirt required
 - tie/bowtie/bolo tie optional
 - no polos or t-shirts allowed
- Sports coat/suit/tux optional
- Nice, clean dress shoes
 - no sandals, Crocs, Birkenstocks, slippers, etc.
 - sneakers and boots in tasteful condition are permitted
- dress hats (such as cowboy hats) permitted
 - no casual hats allowed such as ball caps, beanies, etc.
- <u>JPIIHS</u> students must be clean shaven and have a hairstyle that meets the standard dress code requirements
- Visible tattoos or piercings should not be worn or shown

Guests of JPIIHS Students who are not in compliance with the dress code, may not be admitted to the dance and/or will be escorted out of the dance. No refunds will be given to students who must leave for dress code infractions. If a JPIIHS student's guest does not adhere to the dress code, the JPIIHS student will receive a one-hour detention.
