

Midyear Reports (transcripts)

Do your colleges *require* midyear transcripts?

If your school **requires** one, it will be listed in SchoolLinks in the Counselor Documents column (see example below) as requested by you. Once semester 1 grades are finalized by the district (around January 15) counselors will begin sending them. You do not need to request

If your school *does not automatically require a midyear report for every student*, but they have asked you for one, you need to request one using this form. You will be asked to sign into your D214 email. **If you are requesting midyears to be sent to multiple schools, please complete this form multiple times.** **Note:** Many schools do not want or accept midyear (7th semester) reports (transcripts), so only request them when they ask you for one or if it's optional and you would like one sent.
