

## **Tempo Maestro Privacy Policy**

This privacy policy has been compiled to better inform users of “Tempo Maestro” of how data related to their use of the app is being stored and used online.

### **What personal data do we collect and possess?**

We collect no personally identifiable information through the application. Through our data collection process, users are given a unique, anonymous ID which is linked to their training and testing data. We will keep track of that user ID and then data points such as the scores for each training and testing iteration, and raw tempo data, stored as timestamps.

### **When do we collect data?**

We collect information when you first open our app in terms of a unique ID which is assigned to each user. After that, we collect information related to the user’s tempo data each time a training or testing mode is participated in.

### **How is the data used?**

The user’s information is used strictly from a research standpoint. There will be no selling of this information to a third party for any purpose whatsoever. The data will only be observed by the developers of Tempo Maestro for research purposes.

### **How do we protect your information?**

The user’s information will be stored using Apple’s Cloudkit interface, which is an encrypted server directly integrated with iCloud.

### **How long will we keep the data?**

We will keep the data for as long as our research project is sustained and your consent is granted. You as the user reserve the right to revoke consent and have your data deleted from our server at any time while keeping it maintained on your personal device. So long as consent is maintained, the expected duration of the project is 8 - 10 months. If it ends up being longer, all users will be notified and given the option to opt out if desired.

### **What rights do I have?**

If you are a resident of the European Economic Area (EEA), you have certain data protection rights. For our purposes, we extend these same guidelines to residents outside of the EEA. For any user of Tempo Maestro, if you wish to be further informed what personal data we hold about you or if you want it to be removed from our systems, please contact us.

You have the following data protection rights:

- The right to access, update or to delete the information we have on you
- The right of rectification
- The right to object
- The right of restriction
- The right to data portability
- The right to withdraw consent

Tempo Maestro is an application that doubles as a research tool for gathering information on user's tempo reproduction and identification abilities.
