Class Overview

Math 3 is a high school mathematics course designed for students who have successfully acquired and mastered basic Algebra and Geometry skills from Math 1 & Math 2. In this course, we will discuss linear and quadratic equations and their graphs, functions, polynomials, rational expressions, and basic data analysis. We will also discuss the topics of exponential and logarithmic functions, geometry, and basic trigonometric functions.
