## ***Regular Meeting Minutes***

August 11, 2025

### **I. Call to order**

Angela Jackson, Township Clerk, called to order the meeting of the Fairview Township at 7:00 pm

### **II. Roll call**

The following persons were present: Max Andersen, Mike Seiner, Todd Mockler, Jamie Neitzke, Angela Jackson (Clerk).

### **III. Old Business**

#### **1) Approval of minutes from last meeting**

1. Minutes from the July 14, 2025, meeting were read. Motion to approve by Max Anderson. Seconded by Todd Mockler. Motion passed and minutes approved.

### **IV. New business**

- 1) Nate and Karli Hinds of 2883 Corral Lane representing the residents in the development created by Roger Turner presented their concerns and questions regarding who is responsible for road maintenance in their development. The Board of Supervisors explained that this is considered a private road. The board of supervisors recommended forming a road association. The board of supervisors walked through the process of how to start the process for a road association. The residents in the development have been maintaining the road themselves and applying dust suppression and paying for it themselves. No action taken by board of supervisors.
- 2) Warrant Listing - Treasurer presented the warrant listing for July expenditures of \$13,075.53 including payroll. No Deposits. See attached warrant listing.  
Motion by Todd Mockler. Second by Max Anderson. Approved. See attached warrant listing.
- 3) The Association has not paid any of their share bills on the Burbank Schoolhouse in 2025 including their share of the schoolhouse electrical bill. Insurance bill is due for \$1,459/annually, of which they should pay for one half per a court order. Action item: Jamie to send a copy of the insurance bill to the association and then send Angela the list of outstanding bills, so Angela can send them a letter of the situation and invite them to the next township meeting.
- 4) On street parking ordinances in Burbank - there is an ordinance for on-street limits, but it likely is in the cabinet at the Burbank Schoolhouse.

5) CD at Voyage coming up for maturity. It renews for \$19,743.01 at 4.51% in September. Motion to renew on September 17th by Todd Mockler. Seconded by Mike Seiner. Motion passed.
