## **Options After High School**

#### 4-Year College or University, Community College or Trade School

- → If you are planning to apply straight to a **4-year college**, applications are primarily due in the fall and there will be various other deadlines throughout the year.
  - UCs and Common App Schools require personal statements. Check out the prompts here: <u>UC Personal Insight Questions/Common App Prompts</u>
- → Now is the time to reach out for your Letters of Recommendation for both your college apps and scholarships. You will need to FHS Request for Letter of Recommendation from a few adults that you know educationally, athletically or personally for your college & scholarship applications. Be sure to request your recommendation letters early! Be sure to give your recommenders at least two weeks notice!
- → If you are planning to apply to Community College, applications open in late fall.
- → For those of you looking at **Trade Schools**, deadlines vary throughout the year and many are built into Community Colleges like Sierra and American River.

## Here are some important admission/application dates and deadlines for you to keep in mind this year:

- ★ It's OPEN: <u>UC Application</u> and <u>Common App</u> for Fall of 2025 are now open
- ★ October 1st: CSU Application Opens & Submission Open for UC App
- ★ December 2nd: CSU & UC Application Final Deadline extended until Dec. 2nd.
- ★ **December:** FAFSA/CADA Opens (*Tentative*)
- ★ March/April: FAFSA/CADA Priority Deadline (*Tentative*)
- ★ May 15th: Final Date to Commit to a UC College

Out-of-State, Private, and Trade Schools have varying deadlines!


