A. To qualify for CSF membership, follow these guidelines:

- You must earn a *minimum of 10 points* from last semester's grades (**Term 2, January 2025 to May 2025**).
 - The first 7 *points* must be from LISTS I and II - or all points may come from List I only.
 - The remaining points may come from any LIST (I, II, or III).
- You must use no more than 5 courses to qualify.
- No CSF points are given for physical education, courses taken in lieu of physical education, subjects repeated to improve a grade, courses involving clerking and office/teaching assist, and courses taken on a pass/fail basis.
- CSF points are granted as follows:
 - a grade of A = 3 CSF points.
 - a grade of B = 1 CSF point. (One additional point shall be granted for a grade of A or B in an AP or Honors course, up to a maximum of two such points per semester)
 - a grade of C = 0 CSF points.
 - a grade of D or F in any course, even in one you cannot use to qualify, **disqualifies** you from membership at this time.

B. Also remember:

- Semester membership is based on work done in the *previous* semester.
- You should apply *each* semester. To receive "Life Membership" and recognition at graduation you must have a minimum 4 of 6 qualifying semesters (sophomore-senior years) with **AT LEAST ONE SEMESTER FOR YOUR SENIOR YEAR**.
- Courses you may use are listed on the reverse side. They are divided into LISTS I, II, and III.
