Registration: Now - June 2, 2023

Orientation Dates: June 21st - 22nd and June 23rd

Summer School: July 1st - August 12th

- Steps for enrolling in Summer Intersession at Innovation High School
 - 1. Communicate with your student's current school counselor that you are interested in summer school and complete the summer school interest form:

- 5. Choose an orientation date (email with options sent from Melissa or Alfonso)
- 6. Attend Orientation (this step is required for both student and a parent, please plan your vacations accordingly)
