FAIR QUEEN DRESS CODE:

Wearing of the Fair Queen crown and/or sash is to be considered an honor and privilege. The bearer is now an ambassador representing herself, her family, her community, and her Fair.

While fashion styles may change, good taste does not!

Therefore responsible, appropriate and professional appearance is expected while the Queen is wearing her crown and sash:

Attire that is conducive to the specific appearance or event (i.e. business casual, formal, etc.)

- <u>No</u> jeans, sneakers, flip flops, or boots
- <u>No</u> visible piercings (other than earrings)
- No visible tattoos
- <u>No</u> outfit that shows cleavage
- Dresses/skirts must be no shorter than the height of a dollar bill (approx. 2.5") from the bottom of the dress/skirt hem to the top of the knee cap.
- No clothing that advertises, promotes, or glorifies the use of alcohol, tobacco, drugs, or anything inconsistent with the dignity of the Queen Program.

These rules are modeled after and are in accordance with the State Fair Queen Contest Rules Updated as of 2022 at Convention in Hershey. Any questions regarding dress code can be clarified with any member of the royalty committee.
