1. Panel _____	A. The panel closest to the viewer.
2. Frame _____	B. An image that extends to and/or beyond the edge of the page.
3. Gutter _____	C. A term that describes the way some images draw the eye more than others, creating a definite focus using color and shading in various ways.
4. Bleed _____	D. The lines and borders that contain the panels.
5. Foreground _____	E. These are boxes containing a variety of text elements, including scene-setting, description, etc.
6. Graphic Weight _____	F. The space between framed panels.
7. Captions _____	H. These enclose dialogue and come from a specific speaker's mouth; they vary in size, shape, and layout and can alternate to depict a conversation.
8. Speech Balloons _____	J. This is a method of drawing attention to text; it often highlights onomatopoeia and reinforces the impact of words such as bang or wow.
9. Special-effects lettering _____	K. A distinct segment of the comic, containing a combination of image and text in endless variety.
