The Philomath Booster Club is pleased to offer up to 4 scholarships for secondary education. The scholarships may be awarded in the amounts of \$500 to \$1,000.

Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a graduating senior from Philomath High School or Philomath Academy* and plan to attend an accredited community college, vocational technical school, or a four-year college or university which will lead to a college degree or license.
**Graduating senior from Philomath Academy must be eligible to play sports with PHS to be eligible to apply for this scholarship.*
- Applicant's parent/guardian must have been an active volunteer in support of Philomath Booster Club for at least one year. Please note that work performed in exchange for waiver of fees is not considered toward scholarship volunteer hours.
- Applicant's parent/guardian must have been an active volunteer in support of Philomath athletics/activities for at least one year.
- For 2023-2024 there is no requirement for the applicant to achieve a varsity letter.
- There is no financial need requirement.

Application Requirements:

1. Completed Philomath Booster Club Warrior Scholarship Application Form (attached).
2. Transcript of grades (unofficial copy is acceptable).
3. One letter of recommendation from a coach, advisor, teacher, or counselor.
4. A **one-page** narrative:
 - a. Explain why you are deserving of this award. Please explain your goals, future plans, and the importance of this scholarship to you (250-word maximum).
 - b. List your school and volunteer activities, leadership and awards.
 - c. List your family's volunteer activities supporting PBC and Philomath athletics/activities.

Submission Deadline:

Complete application **must be postmarked by Tuesday, April 1st** and must be mailed to Philomath Booster Club, PO Box 1088, Philomath OR 97370 Hand-delivered applications will not be accepted.

Selection:

- Applicants may be evaluated on factors such as sportsmanship, citizenship, athleticism, extracurricular activities, leadership, community service, and GPA.
- Applicants may be evaluated on volunteerism by the student and family with Philomath Booster Club.
- Nominating Committee: The Executive Board of the Philomath Booster Club will serve as the nominating committee and will review applicants and pass a list of recommended candidates to an award committee.
- Award Committee: An award committee is comprised of at least three Philomath School District faculty/administrative staff and will determine the scholarship winner(s) from the list recommended by the nominating committee.

Payment of Scholarship:

- The Booster Club will write the check to the recipient of the scholarship, not the university or college.
