

220 Sunday Net

Note: This document will be shared publicly. Anything in red should not be read aloud.

INTRO Good evening. The time is now 1930 hours in Vancouver. Welcome to the Surrey Amateur Radio Communications Society's **220 Sunday Net**. My name is (Your Name) and my personal call sign is (Your Call Sign). I will be the Net Control Operator tonight.

This net takes place on the last Sunday of each month at 7:30 pm and is open to all amateur radio operators. We would like to thank the Surrey Amateur Radio Communications Society for the use of this repeater. Emergency and priority traffic should break in at any time.

This is not a conversational net. The purpose of this net is to test our 220 radio equipment and to send and receive signal reports. For general discussion, please join us in a few minutes (or say the exact number of minutes until 8 pm if you want) at the Sunday Check In And Chat net on VE7RPT at 20 hundred hours.

CHECK INS Let's begin our check-ins. Please come now one at a time with your call sign in phonetics.

Engage each check-in as they come. Example:

STATION: VA7ZEB

NCO: VA7ZEB, I have you 5/9 full quieting. How do you copy Net Control?

STATION: This is VA7ZEB, I also have you 5/9 full quieting.

NCO: VA7ZEB, thank you for checking in. 73. Next station, please.

Continue until Nothing Heard.

COMMENTS / FEEDBACK Do we have any comments or feedback about tonight's net? Please come now.

Engage briefly with each. If things get too deep, encourage them to take it to the next net at 8 pm. Stay mindful that the net must end before 8 pm.

Do we have any further comments or feedback about tonight's net? *Continue until* Nothing Heard.

CLOSING I will now bring the **220 Sunday Net** to a close for tonight. We would like to thank everyone who participated. On behalf of the Surrey Amateur Radio Communications Society, this is (Your Call Sign) standing down and returning the repeater to normal use.
