

# ProPresenter Operator

## *Overall “Win” of this Team:*

The ProPresenter Operator plays a key role at Lakepoint Church by leading worship through providing lyrics, Scripture, and onscreen media in a timely and distraction-free manner. The ProPresenter Operator will become familiar with the layout of Sunday services and work alongside the Audio Engineer or Service Producer to cue slides and multimedia at the appropriate time. This is an excellent opportunity for anyone looking to begin their journey in production and contribute to the worship experience at Lakepoint Church.

## *Core Responsibilities*

- Cue multimedia onscreen during Sunday services (slides, background music, videos, etc.).
- Serve during the **Sunday service** when scheduled.
- Attend **Thursday rehearsals** as needed for preparation.
- Work closely with the Audio Engineer or Service Producer and worship team to ensure a smooth flow during services.
- Troubleshoot and resolve any media-related issues during rehearsals or worship gatherings in a calm and efficient manner.

## *Qualifications*

- Willingness to learn and grow in technical production skills.
- Eager to serve and collaborate with the entire Production Team.
- Punctual and dependable, with a commitment to the team.
- Willing to serve **2 hours on Thursdays** for rehearsal and **3 hours on Sundays** when scheduled.

# Front of House (FOH) Audio Engineer

## *Overall “Win” of this Team*

The Front of House (FOH) Audio Engineer helps create a distraction-free environment for worship by providing excellent sound quality. The FOH Audio Engineer typically has some musical or mixing background and is eager to learn more about the church's sound systems. Responsibilities include maintaining proper volume levels, mixing the band and vocalists, and managing audio transitions to ensure an environment where the congregation can engage in worship and hear the message clearly.

## *Core Responsibilities*

- Support the audio vision and direction for worship.
- Provide audio support, troubleshooting, and mixing during services.
- Maintain balanced and healthy audio levels for worship services.
- Partner with the Propresenter Operator and Producer (when available) to ensure smooth transitions with media and audio cues.
- Serve during **one Sunday service** when scheduled.
- Attend **Thursday rehearsals** to ensure proper sound checks and preparation.

## *Qualifications*

- Faith in Christ and membership (or pursuing membership) at Lakepoint Church.
- Able to work under pressure and manage unexpected technical challenges.
- Willing to learn new methods, technologies, and techniques especially after full training is complete.
- Willing to serve **2 hours on Thursdays** for rehearsal and **3 hours on Sundays** when scheduled.

# Camera Switcher

## *Overall “Win” of this Team*

The Camera Switcher coordinates the live video feed, slides, and camera shots to create a cohesive and dynamic service experience. This role involves managing what viewers see online and controlling the flow of different media onscreen during the service. The Camera Switcher is responsible for ensuring a smooth, engaging visual experience and is well-suited for someone who enjoys managing multiple elements at once and has an interest in cinematography or directing.

## *Core Responsibilities*

- Switch between cameras for variety and visual interest in shots.
- Communicate with camera operators to prompt shots and maintain consistent coverage.
- Serve during **one Sunday service** when scheduled.
- Coordinate with the Service Producer about the order of service and the integration of media.
- Ensure smooth transitions between live footage, slides, and video elements.

- A follower of Jesus Christ.
- Willingness to learn and grow in video production skills.
- Eager to work collaboratively with the Production Team.
- A servant's heart and a commitment to leading by example.
- Willing to serve **2 hours on Sundays** when scheduled.

# Camera Operator

The Camera Operator captures footage for Lakepoint Church's live services, livestream, and archives simultaneously. They play a key role in documenting moments of worship, ensuring that shots reflect the heart of the church, the energy of worship, and the emotion of the moment.

## Core Responsibilities

- Capture video footage for livestreaming and recording purposes.
- Operate the main camera during service.
- Coordinate with the Camera Switcher and other team members to ensure smooth and cohesive video coverage.

- Collaborative and ready to work as part of a team.
- Background or interest in cinematography, filming, or photography is a plus!

- Learn and practice songs ahead of **Thursday rehearsals**.
- Attend **Thursday rehearsals** as scheduled.
- Serve during **one Sunday service** when scheduled.
- Communicate openly and proactively with the Worship Pastor and team members when needed..
- Cultivate a heart of worship outside of rehearsals and Sunday services.
- Communicate your availability through Planning Center.

## *Qualifications*

- Musical skill that aligns with Lakepoint's worship style (pre-performance assessment required).
- Ability to play with backing tracks, clicks, in-ear monitors, digital charts, etc.
- Humble and flexible, with a teachable spirit.

- Willing to serve **2 hours on Thursdays** for rehearsals and **3 hours on Sundays** when scheduled.

# Worship Vocalist

## *Overall “Win” of this Team*

Vocalists are active in Scripture, committed to a lifestyle of daily worship, and engaged with the wider Lakepoint Church community. They find their confidence in God and approach worship songs personally, for His glory and the building up of the church.

- Learn lyrics and practice songs ahead of **Thursday rehearsals**.
- Attend **Thursday rehearsals** as scheduled.
- Serve during **one Sunday service** when scheduled.
- Communicate openly and proactively with the Worship Pastor and other team members when needed.
- Learn and use Lakepoint's preferred worship tools (backing tracks, clicks, in-ear monitors, digital charts, etc.).
- Cultivate a heart of worship outside of rehearsals and Sunday services.

## *Qualifications*

- Follower of Jesus Christ.
- Vocal ability and blending skills (vocal assessment required).
- Ability to harmonize and "hear" parts in a worship setting.
- Humble and flexible, with a teachable spirit.
- Actively pursuing a relationship with God outside of worship gatherings.
- Willing to follow the leadership of the Worship Pastor and other volunteer leaders and open to being developed and coached.
- Willing to serve **2 hours on Thursdays** for rehearsals and **3 hours on Sundays** when scheduled.
