

Implant Fixed Bridge Warranty

While we cannot guarantee success in your treatment, [Dentist Name] provides a warranty to make sure your new smile and teeth will be protected. Our goal is to provide you with the best experience possible.

[Dentist Name] will place an interim bridge on the implants during the healing period while the implants become secure in the bone. During this time (approximately 4-6 months), [Dentist Name] will monitor the AOX interim bridge and make any necessary repairs before the definitive bridge is placed, as long as you adhere to the dietary restrictions and care instructions we provided and reviewed at previous appointments.

The definitive bridge is designed and built to last many years with proper follow-up care by you as instructed by [Dentist Name]. The definitive bridge will be repaired or replaced at the discretion of [Dentist Name] for a period of no more than three (3) years from insertion, as long as the need for repair or replacement is not the result of your failure to follow home care, failure to return to the office for cleanings of the definitive bridge or barring any trauma. Warranty claims that don't meet these parameters will be considered on a case-by-case basis. If you fail to attend your yearly visit your warranty will be void.

The prosthetic teeth themselves may eventually wear down from natural chewing. This wear and tear normally occurs after several years of function and will vary from one patient to another. The prosthetic teeth can always be replaced with new teeth if/when necessary. There is a separate cost associated with replacement due to normal wear and tear. Additionally, there will be a fee for the replacement of any screws during your hygiene visits, if needed, to ensure secure stabilization of your teeth.

After the definitive bridge is placed, it is important we see you [number of visits] visits each year for dental cleanings to maintain the gum health around the implants and to keep your smile looking sharp! Your first cleaning is free of charge. There will be a fee for each cleaning appointment thereafter.

It is important for the long-term success of your dental implants that you practice excellent oral hygiene at home, including utilizing a WaterPik® and a soft toothbrush. You should only use a toothpaste with low abrasion (we will give you a list of recommended toothpastes). If you cannot keep your teeth and dental implants clean in between professional cleaning visits, you will need to be seen at our office more frequently.
