Continuous Improvement Plan Updates – presentation by Des Hertz

Academic Achievement Goal – Des shared the reading and math assessments with a comparison between fall and winter. You should expect to see growth between fall and winter. Question on if there

is a comparison between the schools? Des can share the SU as a whole along with Cabot but not a school-to-school comparison.

Safe and Healthy School Goal – Des shared attendance rates and behaviors that are measured. Discussion on what causes the absences. It would have to be drilled into.

Policy B20 - Personnel Recruitment, Selection, Appointment, And Background Checks (Recommended). An update to existing policy that outlines SU and District practices related to background checks for potential employees. (Discussion/Possible Adoption) - SU will now pay for the background checks.

Policy D24 (formerly D7) - Special Education - Update to a required policy that outlines the SU responsibilities to meet the needs of students with disabilities. (Discussion/Possible Adoption) - there is no change to the actual policy.

A **motion** to pass Policy B20 and Policy D24 as submitted by Ellen Cairns and seconded by Alicia Heber. Motion passed.

Nursing Contract – Currently contracted with the health center. The health center will no longer contract out a nurse. The school will need to hire a nurse for the FY25/26 school year. Matt will look at the FTE needed for this position and bring back some thoughts.
