Relative to: New Hampshire Electoral College Votes

Be it enacted by the YMCA Youth Legislature of New Hampshire as follows:

Section I: New Hampshire's four electoral votes will be assigned to the presidential candidates in proportion to the statewide popular vote.

Section II: Apportionment.

- (a) A candidate with 0-19.9% of the popular vote will receive 0 electoral votes.
- (b) A candidate with 20-40% of the popular vote will receive 1 electoral vote.
- (c) A candidate with 40.1-59.9% of the popular vote will receive 2 electoral votes.
- (d) A candidate with 60-79.9% of the popular vote will receive 3 electoral votes.
- (e) A candidate with 80-100% of the popular vote will receive 4 electoral votes.

Section III: If the popular vote percentages result in not all 4 electoral votes being given away, the candidate with the highest amount of popular votes will be given the remaining electoral votes. Section IV: This bill shall go into effect immediately upon passage.
