Connie Sauer-Adams Scholarship

Honoring Tallahassee resident Carolyn Sauer-Adams (1938-2021), an avid supporter of music and passionate educator. Connie spent her career working to bring hope and educational opportunity to a vulnerable population of students. She enthusiastically encouraged the musicians in her life to use their talents to cultivate and share beauty as performers and teachers.

Purpose: To support the summer musical studies of young Black and Latinx classical string players. Scholarships range from \$500-\$1000.

Eligibility:

- Instrument categories: Violin, Viola, Cello, and Double Bass
- Must be currently enrolled in high school, college, or graduate school
- Must be a U.S. resident or have a valid U.S. visa at the time of applying and summer study.
- Applicants must be a resident of Florida, Georgia, Alabama, or Mississippi.

Application Process:

- Deadline: March 21, 2025
- Submit the following materials:
 - Application Form
 - Recording of two contrasting works that represent your playing
 - o Bio
 - o Publicity Photo
- Award recipients will be notified by April 4, 2025. Awards will be sent directly to the festival of the winner's choosing.
