Early Primary Grades K – 2nd



Student progress for Kindergarten – 2nd grade is reported to parents at the end of each nine week grading period. Progress reports are also sent during the midterm of the 1st and 3rd quarter. Parent/guardian conferences are held during the 2nd and 4th quarter to communicate progress. Students receive a rating based on their level of understanding of each specific content area skill.

3rd – 5th Grades

3rd – 5th grade students receive a printed midterm report after 4 ½ weeks and a printed report card at the end of the nine week grading period. Parent/guardian conferences are held during the 2nd and 4th quarter to communicate progress. The grading scale for 3rd – 5th grade students can be found below.
