



Privacy Notice

The APPG on Children in Police Custody processes your personal data for the purposes of maintaining and using a membership list, and keeping minutes of meetings.

The data which we obtain from you and process is:

- Your name, title and email address
- Your role (eg MP), and/or the organisation that you work for (if any)

We use this information to send you information about the APPG and its work, including meeting notices and minutes. We may also record personal information about you, including your opinions, in minutes of meetings.

Our lawful basis for using this information is legitimate purposes, namely that we obtain and process your data as an activity carried out in the public interest that supports or promotes democratic engagement.

We will hold this information securely and we will keep this information for five years.

We will share this personal data only with our contracted data processor(s), who is Dr Miranda Bevan, Goldsmiths, University of London. This individual provides a secretariat for the APPG.

Please also note that under the rules which Parliament has set for APPGs, the names of APPG members (but not their contact details) are published on the group's webpages ([APPG on Children in Police Custody](#)) or else provided to enquirers on request.
