Section V Cross Country Sports Committee (Boys and Girls)

The sports committee consists of:

- Boys Sectional chairpersons
- Girls Sectional chairpersons
- Chairpersons from each league

The sports committee is responsible for:

- Organizing and conducting Sectional class championships.
- Conducting State Qualifier meet
- Determining how teams and individuals qualify for NYS championships.
- Selecting a Jury of Appeals for Sectionals.
- Recommend any changes for the sport of Cross Country.

** Any policy that requires the committee to vote shall use the following procedure:

- Each league has one vote for each gender
- League chairpersons may send a proxy vote with a designated representative.
- Fifty percent of the possible votes constitute a quorum.
- Sixty percent will carry the vote.
- The vote of each Sectional chairperson will be used to decide the outcome of a vote if needed.

Section V Cross Country will follow National Federation Rules (Rule 9, sections 1-7) and all rules of eligibility found in the NYSPHSAA handbook.

Publicity Standards

Schedules

The official website for Section V Athletics - www.sectionv.org - will always have the latest and most up to date schedules. Each athletic administration office will update their schedules within the rSchoolToday platform and that schedule automatically synchronizes to the Section V website. The home team school is typically responsible for any changes to their schedule. Please contact your athletic director's office with any questions about schedules.

Rosters

All roster submissions can be handled within the rSchoolToday platform. Athletic directors and coaches will have access and can update their school rosters. If your team is combined with another or many schools not within your own school district, then each school athletic director can update and input their student roster submission from their specific school to form a complete roster. All changes and updates should be taken up with your coach and/or athletic department. What is reflected on the Section V website is from the data they have inputted and can control.

Please note that rSchoolToday Activity Scheduler follows Ed Law 2d and FERPA laws regarding student data. Only data that schools should be inputting online for rosters:

- First Name
- Last Name
- Grade Level

Anything additional would be specific for a sport or school decision on things like height or weight. Please consult with your athletic director and sport coordinator.

Results

All results or scores should be reported immediately following the game by the winning team on the rSchoolToday platform. Coaches will be provided necessary access to do this from their athletic directors. Section V only needs the result of the contest. Any additional reporting of results can be done once rSchoolToday results have been inputted, which should only take a few seconds from Activity Scheduler rSchoolToday Mobile App. Online content managers for each sport will be checking frequently and assisting schools and coaches with getting their input in a timely fashion. This is important to help determine sectional standings as games are inputted.

Social Media

Please follow the <u>Social Media Policy</u> and all of the official <u>Section V Social Media Accounts</u> that should be utilized to highlight things going on in your specific sport. Another resource is the <u>School-Run Social Media Accounts</u> directory, which is updated as schools provide details.

Media

All members of the media can provide their information <u>using this form</u> and Section V will add their information to an online directory for all sports to utilize. Section V encourages all coaches and athletic directors to use this directory to highlight their student athletes. All of our media do a fantastic job of covering high school sports and we must all do our part to help them get the information they need in a timely fashion.

Sectional Eligibility

- May not start practice before approved starting dates set by NYSPHSAA, Section V or Leagues.
- Must follow state requirements for practice and participation
- Must run in a minimum of six (6) contests prior to Sectionals
- Any modified runner moved up to varsity competition must be moved up <u>prior to 50% of their school's modified schedule.</u>

Medical Waiver Request

If an athlete does not have 6 separate meet participations, he/she cannot be entered into the sectional meet. If the reason for not having 6 competitions is a medical reason then the school may ask for a medical waiver of the 6 competition rule from the Section V Executive Director. Only waivers for medical reasons are allowed. A medical waiver request form must be submitted by the school athletic director with all pertinent information listed on the form. The form can be found on <u>sectionv.org</u>. Schools will be notified of approval/denial.

Sectional Entries

- The Cross Country Sectionals are an open format. All teams and individuals are invited if they have met NYSPHSAA standards.
- The number of entries will be regulated by the Sports Committee.
- Each team will be allowed to enter seven (7) runners.
- Entry form and athlete verification can be obtained online (x-c link of sectiony.org)
- All entries must be received by 8:00 PM Sunday, November 2, 2025. Late entries must go through the appeals process. Changes in entries may be made up to 1 hour prior to your race with Dave Yen.
- The <u>Sectional Committee</u> has the right to rule on all extenuating circumstances.

Sectionals

Sectional site(s) will be recommended to the Athletic Council by the Sports Committee.

Starting times will be voted on by the sports committee.

- Starting line positions will be assigned. 7 runners on the line.
- Uniform Rule will be strictly enforced. Any illegal runners or teams will be disqualified.
- Coaches are responsible for runners wearing the correct bib number on the front of their uniform.
- Scoring will be by computer. Official results will be posted after each race.
- Final results will be posted on the internet at the end of the day: sectionv.org website.
- This is a Championship Meet! Coaches are expected to supervise their athletes. No footballs, frisbees, etc.
- Dogs and other pets are not allowed at the sectional sites.
- The course is closed the week leading up to the championship meet
- No bikes allowed on the course during the meet.
- All vehicles will be charged to park in the parking area: \$11.50/car-Tickets will be sold online CLICK HERE

Disqualifications and Protests

Judgment calls by officials cannot be protested. If the head coach would like to protest the misapplication of a sport specific rule, the protest must be made immediately to the game official prior to resuming play. Once play resumes, any protest is null and void. Per NYSPHSAA, in any case, video may not be used to overturn an official's decision.

Awards

- Trophy, t-shirts, medals and patches are awarded to the team champion in each sectional class.
- Medals are awarded to the 2nd place team.
- Patches to top ten (10) individuals in each sectional class. (15) individual patches in Girls Class D.
- *** Awards ceremony will be at the designated times.

New York State Championships

A. Qualifiers:

Overall <u>winning team</u> (8 runners maximum) and coach in each State CLASS A, B, C, D will represent Section V. (Boys D Representatives will be the winning team from the class D/DD blends).

***No others without coordinator's approval.

Overall top 5 individuals not on the winning team in each State CLASS A, B, C, D will represent Section V.

• Individual runners will be supervised by the Sectional chairpersons and Section V chaperones.

B. NYSPHSAA AWARDS:

- Championship plaque and medals to the winning team.
- Medals to top 20 in each race.
- T-Shirt to the top 10 runners on the Championships Intersectional Team.
- The **Sportsmanship Awards** will be selected from the athletes on Section V State Team and a vote of league chairs

C. Qualifying for NYS Federation:

- Based on performance in NYSPHSAA Championships.
- Rankings throughout the year.
- Information provided by coach (due by 11/12/25).

All Section V Cross Country Selection Process

- The Top 30 finishers on the blend of all class races will determine the All Section V All-Star Team.
 - o 1st team will be places 1-10
 - o 2nd team will be places 11-20
 - o 3rd team will be places 21-30
- There will be an All-Star banquet which historically has been the Sunday after the NYS Federation Championships. Date and time is to be determined.
