INTRODUCTION

The introductory section contains the background, research context, urgency of the problem, results of the main literature review which is the basis of the research, previous research results that are relevant to the research study, research objectives, and theoretical framework. The entire introductory section is presented in an integrated manner in paragraph form, not divided into sections written in the chapter model of a research report/thesis/thesis/dissertation, and the number of words is between 3000-7000 words. The words INTRODUCTION, METHODS, RESULTS AND DISCUSSION, CONCLUSION, and LIST use capital letters (UPPERCASE).

Additional information, especially regarding the size of the paper used, is A4 size, with top and bottom spacing of 3 cm, left and right spacing of 2.5 cm, header 1.7 and footer 1.25.

METHOD

The research method shows the scientific procedures carried out by the author to produce conclusions. The method contains research approaches and methods, data sources/populations and samples, methods for selecting samples/determining data sources, instruments and methods for data collection, and data analysis techniques. This section contains a description of research procedures and steps according to the topic studied.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

The results of data analysis are presented in the form of patterns, characteristics, statistical analysis, hypothesis testing, and others according to research characteristics. This results and discussion section is the most important part of the article so the author is asked to provide a complete and clear discussion. The discussion section contains a presentation of the results of data analysis which is in line with the objectives/problems studied and the procedures described in the methods section. The discussion contains the meaning of the research results that have been described.

The discussion is carried out by (1) interpreting research findings, (2) integrating findings into the structure of knowledge, (3) uncovering new findings (new theories or modifications to existing theories), and (4) explaining the implications of the findings theoretically and practically.

You should use tables only to improve conciseness or where the information cannot be given satisfactorily in other ways such as histograms or graphs. Tables should be numbered serially and referred to in the text by number (table 1, etc.). Each table should have an explanatory caption which should be as concise as possible.
