Conclusion summarize the main conclusions or interpretations of the study and provide recommendations for future research, further analysis, or practical action, if applicable.

The abstract must be written all in one paragraph, in English, with a maximum length of 250 words.

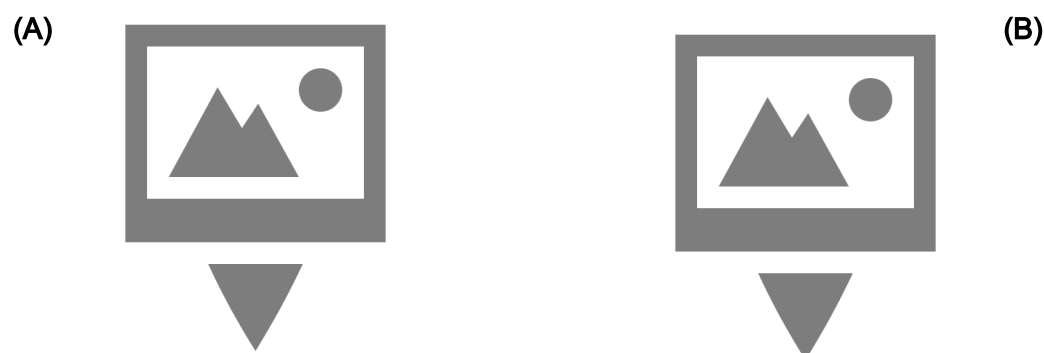


Figure 1. This is a title of the figure **(A)** This is a description of picture A; **(B)** This is a description of picture B (font 10)
