**Agency Performance Report
3rd Quarter 2023
(July-September 2023)**

Introduction

The quarter showed several accomplishments and interventions under the three (3) program components of the Philippine Population and Development Program (PPDP).

I. Responsible Parenthood and Family Planning (RP/FP) Program

A. Demand Generation

For July-September 2023, CPD-Region II provided technical assistance on the following RPPF activities:

1. Orientations on Kalalakinghang Tapat sa Responsibilidad at Obligasyon sa Pamilya (KATROPA) for the following Local Government Units (LGUs):
 - A. Tuguegarao City - BASTA TODA KATROPA: KATROPA goes to Barangay on July 7, 14 & 21, 2023; August 4, 11, 18 & 25) and September 1 and 8 attended by 306 male participants;
 - B. Rizal, Cagayan on July 13, 2023 attended by 40 males and 3 females; and
 - C. Quezon, Isabela – September 22, 2023 attended by 42 males and 6 females.
3. Responsible Parenthood and Family Planning (RPPF) Orientation in the Workplace for the following LGU and institutions:
 - A. City of Ilagan on July 21, 2023 attended by 8 males and 22 females; and
 - B. Philippine National Police Regional Office No. 2 on September 26, 2023 attended by 27 males and 13 females.
4. 2023 Buntis Congress in Tuguegarao City on July 8, 2023, attended by 189 females;
5. Fertility Awareness and Family Planning Orientation for CPD-RII employees, Government Internship Program (GIPs) and On-the Job Trainees (OJTs) on August 23, 2023 attended by 3 males and 7 females; and
6. RPPF Caravan in Sto, Niño, Cagayan on August 31, 2023 attended by 5 males and 70 females where seventeen (17) new acceptors of Progestin Subdermal Implant and others with Progestin-Only Pills and injectable were provided FP services as highlight of the FP Month Celebration.

For the 3rd Quarter, a total of 28,730 (7,595 4Ps, 4,667 Non-4Ps, 1,834 Usapan Serye, 13,402 Pre-Marriage Counseling and 1,232 House to House) couples and

individuals were reached and manually encoded in the database. 1,611 were successfully referred and 2,847 couples/individuals with unmet need were identified.

FP LOGISTICS

The Family Planning (FP) Logistics operation which is coordinated through the FP Logistics Coordinator/Population Representative monitored and undertook the following activities:

1. Prepared the Warehouse Inventory Report for June, July and August 2023 and submitted to CPD RII- Supply Chain Management on July 5, August 17, and September 15, 2023 respectively;
2. Consolidated the FP Logistics Report Template 3 for the 2nd Quarter 2023 on July 24, 2023;
3. Assisted the following Provincial/City Population Offers, City Health Offices, Rural Health Units and Offices (P/CPOs/CHOs/RHUs/ Office):
 - A. RHU San Agustin, Isabela with their concern on near stock out. The RHU requested for additional allocation of FP commodities on July 5, 2023;
 - B. RHU Sta. Ana, Cagayan regarding their inability to encode in the online Inventory Order Report (IOR) database. The issue was addressed immediately on July 11, 2023;
 - C. RHU Angadanan, Isabela regarding their inability to encode in the online IOR database. The issue was addressed immediately on July 11, 2023;
 - D. PPO Nueva Vizcaya regarding the concern of incomplete submission of IORs from the Province. Upon verification of the database, the IORs were accomplished but not reflected in the Templates 1 and 3 of the FP Logistics Report IOR online database. The PPO staff was informed that all “red boxes” should be filled out otherwise it will not be reflected automatically in the templates 1 and 3. The PPO staff was provided with the link and access to the FP IOR database for monitoring and submission of IORs of the province; and
 - E. RHU Aparri, Cagayan regarding their request to register another gmail account to the FP IOR online database due to no access of their old gmail account. The concern was addressed immediately on August 16, 2023.
4. Conducted Warehouse Inventory (counting of available FP commodities in the warehouse) on September 12, 2023;



5. Facilitated the following concerns:

- A. Delivery of 3000 cycles POP and 45 rods of PSI to DOH CVCHD on August 8, 2023;
- B. Putting up/placing of 6 panels of warehouse tarpaulins through the help of CPD-RII drivers and utilities on July 21, 2023;
- C. Responded to the request of 300 rods of PSI for the FP activities of a partner CSO which is the Building Intertribal Economic Development (BITE) Incorporated on August 30, 2023. The commodities were immediately picked-up by BITE on September 30, 2023 at CPD RII;
- D. Responded to the request of CPO Santiago City for 100 rods of PSI and 5 boxes of condoms requested on August 19, 2023 and delivered on September 12, 2023 using the CPD RII official vehicle; and
- E. Posting of the list of LGUs with no or incomplete IOR reports for 2nd Quarter 2023 in the FP group chat (per province) as of July 10, 2023 and reminded the FP Focal Persons to accomplish the IOR report via the online database:
