Odysseyware Grading Guidelines 20/21

- 1. All Lessons, Projects, Quizzes, Tests and Finals passing grades are 70%.
 - a. If a 50% is earned on the assignment then the assignment will be given back with the wrong answers.
 - b. If a 50% is not earned then the assignment will be reset completely.
 - c. If at any point your score does not improve from the previous attempt to the current attempt then that assignment will be reset completely.
- 2. Students are expected to progress about 8% per week in each of their classes.
 - a. Grading begins second week, so week one is head start week.
 - b. Every Week the percent goes up. Weekly Progress requirements
- 3. With students having 6 classes they should always have an assignment to work on.
 - a. A student may need an assignment open in math, but they should have an open assignment in another class. A student should move on to another class until a teacher is able to open the math assignment they would like to work on.
 - b. If students are being locked out of assignments, it is because the assignment is not being passed on the first try. Spend more time on the assignment and get it right the first time and a student will never need to wait for a teacher to open another lesson.
- 4. Tests will always need to be requested to open.
 - a. If a student has reached a test, they will have to request a teacher to open the test. The test will only be opened if all assignments in the unit have been passed.

5. Please Understand that the entire class must be finished to earn credit in an odysseyware class.

School runs from 9:00 AM - 3:15 PM from Monday-Friday. Teachers are available during that time to open assignments, unblock tests, etc. After those hours, please note that you are still welcome to contact us, but we may not answer until the next scheduled day.
