Generally I do not interact with anyone under 21, but at the very least, this blog is 18+. Anything NSFW will be tagged simply as 'nsfw.' Mutuals exclusive.

PERSONAL BLOGS, please do not interact with my writing-based posts. I will block you.

- 02. I do my best to make my dash a place of positivity & I will do what I need to to keep it that way; hate, drama, vagueposting, callouts, excessive negativity, etc etc and I'll unfollow.
- O3. The best way to **interact** is by sending in memes. My inbox is always open, and memes don't expire here. I do post starter calls too, so feel free to respond to one of those. And of course, you are always welcome to send me a message if you'd like to plot (especially if you take an interest in a particular verse). ## DIVERGENCES


It is really important to note that Peggy's background is *not* purely canon-based. I've had to do a lot of adjusting to ensure she is historically accurate.


There are a couple of reasons for this: I began writing Peggy way back in 2012, when her only appearance was in 2011's *Captain America*: *The First Avenger*. In that wayback time when I began to write her, the SSR file (pictured below) from a deleted scene in the film was all I had to go on as far as her canon backstory was concerned. Of course, Peggy's background has changed and been rewritten a number of time since then – in prequel comics, the *Agent Carter* show, and of course, the various films she's been in, or mentioned in. I use that original file as a baseline (so, rather than having joined the RAF as a nurse at the age of 15, I have changed it to 17, etc etc).

The second reason is that Marvel appears to bend historical timelines to their will (or just outright ignores them). For example: the original SSR dossier on Peggy, pictured below, states that Peg was with the SAS in 1936...but the SAS was not formed until July 1st, 1941.

Over the years, I've tried to reconcile the MCU changes with my take on Peggy for a realistic, *historically* accurate depiction of her. I can't help but feel that she's a tribute to the brave women who served worldwide during the second World War, blazing trails in a world that formerly "shut doors in their face," as Peggy once remarked.

I've noted specific divergences in her verses, but if you have specific questions, please let me know.





### VERSES [MARVEL-BASED]

#### 01. MATN.

Peggy Carter was born April 9, 1919 in London, England to Amanda and Harrison Carter. In 1936, At the age of 17, Peggy became a nurse in the Royal Air Force, having lied about her age to join; by 1939, Peggy had left nursing life and was transferred to the British Royal Military; by 1940, she had been recruited to work as a codebreaker at Bletchley Park.

Meanwhile, Peggy's brother Michael had also recommended his sister for a job at the Special Operations Executive (S.O.E). The organization's purpose was to conduct espionage, sabotage and reconnaissance in occupied Europe, and aid in resistance movements; after some deliberation, Peggy accepted the job. She soon worked her way from the S.O.E. to the S.S.R., becoming an Agent and aiding in Project: Rebirth.

At the war's end, Peggy continued working for the S.S.R., before growing frustrated with their treatment of her and the mountains of red tape that needed to be cut in order to do one simple mission. In the late 1940s, Peggy founded S.H.I.E.L.D. with Howard Stark and Colonel Phillips, while adopting the codename *Agent 13*. Though she began as Director Carter, her career would end with her as Commander Carter.

Peggy bequeathed S.H.I.E.L.D. to Nicholas J. Fury in the 1990s, feeling that she had served her tenure and was due for retirement.

**DIVERGENCY (MAIN, V2):** During her time with the SSR, Peggy was injected with the Project: Rebirth serum sometime in the early 1940s, also receiving the serum but no Vita-Rays. The serum greatly enhanced her mental and physical abilities. An unknown side effect of the serum was slowed aging, which Peggy would not notice until later diagnostic testing administered by Howard.

Having maintained her youth and stamina, she continued to serve as liaison to S.H.I.E.L.D., and later to the Avengers. During the events of *Infinity War*, Peggy was not a victim of the blip. During *Endgame*, she was present at the final battle, joining the Avengers and defeating Thanos once and for all.

A note: I have erased Fred, the fiance from Agent Carter, in just about every verse. Sorry, Fred.

#### 02. CAPTAIN CARTER. WHAT IF ...? COMPLIANT.

During WWII, Steve Rogers had been selected as the candidate who would receive the Super Soldier Serum as a part of *Project: Rebirth.* However, just as Howard Stark was preparing Steve for the procedure, the lab was attacked by a HYDRA spy. That spy managed to kill Phillips and shoot Steve, but Peggy ensured he could injure no more with a precise shot of her own. With limited time left to complete the procedure, Peggy volunteered to take the serum instead. Successfully enhanced but effectively benched due to new S.S.R. leader John Flynn, Peggy remained stagnant until Howard outfitted her with a uniform and vibranium shield. Now armed, Peggy set out to stop Schmidt. After attacking a HYDRA convoy, retrieving the Tesseract *and* Arnim Zola, Peggy was promoted to the rank of Captain.

Peggy went on to fight in numerous battles alongside the Howling Commandos, Bucky Barnes, and Steve Rogers, wearing the 'HYDRA Stomper' suit. Rogers later went missing after an attack on a HYDRA train. Later, Peggy and her allies infiltrated Schmidt's castle using the location obtained from Zola. Here she found Steve alive. However,

Schmidt used the Tesseract to open a portal and summoned an interdimensional creature. Together, Peggy and Steve fought the creature until the HYDRA Stomper ran out of power. As Howard closed the portal, Peggy jumped through, sacrificing herself by pushing the creature through the portal.

Seventy years later, Peggy Carter emerged from a new portal created by the Tesseract, meeting Nick Fury and Clint Barton on arrival. She would have little time to adjust to the new world, however, as the realities of the multiverse would be laid bare for her. After uniting with a number of other multiversal heroes, Peggy returned to the moment she'd been whisked away – bantering with her friend, Natasha, just before a mission on the Lumerian Star – where she would begin to live her life with a wholly new perspective.

## 03. DIRECTOR CARTER. SOMEWHAT MCU COMPLAINT; a continuation of Agent Carter.

The year is 1948. It is post-war, and Peggy Carter has returned stateside to Brooklyn, NY. Alongside Howard Stark and Chester Phillips, Peggy forms S.H.I.E.L.D out of the S.S.R., which itself is later reformed as the scientific division of the organization. In its infancy, the organization seeks to protect from "all possible threats."

### 04. MADEMOISELLE. 616. DESCRIPTION BELOW DIRECTLY FROM COMICS.

"Margaret "Peggy" Carter was born to a wealthy American family during simpler times. When war broke out in Europe, she was not content to idly stand by and watch as the Nazis invaded the continent. Peggy left her comfortable American life to join the French Resistance and soon became one of their bravest and best-trained members.

It was while fighting for their country overseas that she first encountered Captain America. Though their wartime strategies and combat tactics often differed, they were drawn together by a common purpose of service and justice. This bond between the two heroes ultimately blossomed into romance that struggled to endure during the war. Following her service, Peggy became ensconced in the international security agency S.H.I.E.L.D. and furthered her adventures. In the early 1950s, an alien energy source was discovered in Russia, and it's up to Agent Peggy Carter and Howard Stark to find it..."

# 05. THE WINTER SOLDIER. PRESUMABLY, BUCKY NEVER FELL FROM THE TRAIN.

Towards the end of the second World War, a tragic accident occured on what was to be a standard mission: Peggy, having accompanied Steve, Bucky, and the Howling Commandos on a field mission, was eventually presumed M.I.A in an attempted rescue from a HYDRA base that had been rigged to blow. Though Howard Stark searched and searched through the rubble, Peggy could not be found. Unbeknownst to him, she wouldn't have turned up no matter how hard he looked; she'd fallen into the enemy's hands, and for the next seventy years, she would be a ghost story — the *Winter Soldier*. Through painful experiments, cryogenic stasis, and mind wiping, Peggy remained 'the Asset' for nearly seventy years, shaping history in ways she never wanted to.

## VERSES [NON-MARVEL]

#### 06. AGENT 0013. PEGGY AS A DOUBLE-O.

Born April 9, 1981, Major Margaret "Peggy" Carter began her military career with the British Army. She joined at the age of 18, starting as officer cadet and quickly working her way up to Major, a rank which she actively held for nearly a decade. After being recruited by MI6, Maj. Carter completed necessary tasks, training, and tests for the 00-program, and was eventually promoted to 00-status.

#### 07. CAPTAIN CARTER, N7. MASS EFFECT AU

Peggy is an N7 and Captain of the *SRV MIDWAY*, running a program alongside Anderson to seek out and train up the next generation of leaders within the Alliance, people who will be the ones to take the helm and lead their people with honor. She underwent the incredibly risky surgery to replace her L2 with an L3, and so far, everything seems to be in working order. As a Vanguard, she is always out in the front of the fight.

## 08. SPYMASTER. FOR HISTORICAL SETTINGS. FLEXIBLE, MEANT TO FIT FROM THE 1700s-1800s.

Often, the oddest things in the world are hidden in plain sight. It is why Peggy and her dearest friend Howard set out to found S.H.I.E.L.D.; so much strangeness was hidden right underneath their noses, and more often than not, the governments of the world were simply too busy to do anything about it. S.H.I.E.L.D. operates independently and in secret, and Margaret "Peggy" Carter is their Chief Spymaster. A well-educated woman with both street and book smarts, she's a surprisingly dangerous combatant who is as good a spy as she is a martial artist and marksman.
