In 2015, Jonathan relocated with his family from Norfolk, Virginia to Omaha, Nebraska, to begin the work of planting a new ministry. In October 2016, he founded Church On Purpose in North Omaha, where he now serves as Senior Pastor. Under his leadership, the church has grown into a vibrant, community-centered ministry focused on discipleship, relationship-building, and practical teaching that empowers individuals to live as Kingdom citizens in today's world.

In addition to his pastoral leadership, Jonathan serves as Vice President of Community Collaboratives for the African American Empowerment Network. In this role, he provides strategic leadership and support across several high-impact initiatives, including the nationally recognized Omaha 360 Violence Prevention and Intervention Initiative, My Brother's Keeper Omaha (in partnership with the Obama Foundation), the Cradle to Career Education Collaborative, the Healthy Village Collaborative, and the Step-Up Omaha Youth Employment and Entrepreneurship Initiative. He is particularly passionate about his work with Village Zone Faith Leaders, where he advances the Adopt-A-Block strategy to mobilize churches and faith-based organizations to strengthen communities at the neighborhood level.

Jonathan is a committed servant-leader beyond his formal roles. He has previously served as Board Chair of the Hartman Avenue Neighborhood Association and currently serves as Vice President of the Board for Omaha Street School, a committee member for the Presbyterian Church (USA) Self-Development of People Committee, and a youth basketball coach at Nelson Mandela Elementary School.

He believes that many of the world's challenges stem from a lack of purpose, limited freedom to pursue that purpose, and misunderstandings about faith. His life and leadership are devoted to addressing these gaps by helping individuals and communities grow in clarity, capacity, and conviction.
