### **<u>1. School Admin-updates and questions</u>**

Monsieur Belanger's updates:

- Spring concert all primary grades will be performing for the first time for the public. On June 21<sup>st</sup> at 6:30 pm, all families are welcome to come and enjoy the concert.
- Sports Day Thank you PAC and all volunteers for contributing to have a successful sports day. On June 9<sup>th</sup> parents are welcome to come and watch. School ends at 2 pm, but for those who cannot be picked up, can stay till 3 pm in the gym.
- Outdoor rock benches the budget line for the rocks was held in the budget for two years and due to no VSB confirmation till this day, we must cancel it.
- Saleema Noon this year we asked for an online program. For primaries, Body Science and for intermediates is the Growing up game plan program, which will happen in June. Parents will get access to all videos online.
- Next year there will be two French immersion Kindergartens and late French immersion grade 6 with 30 students enrolled. Ms. New Vice Principal in September, thank you Ms. McFadden for being the Acting Vice Principal. We are looking for a new French Kindergarten teacher.
- The 2023/2024 school year calendar will be distributed to all families in June.

Ms. McFadden's updates:

- 79 out of 89 students from grade 7 and 8 staff members spent 3 days at the Camp Jubilee. All three grade 7 classes mixed very well and had fun.
- Last week was the last track and field District meet. Staff's wish for the next year is to get new jerseys for track and field (gr4/5) and for cross country which starts in September (50+ students including primaries). I'm
- There will be an Appreciation Volunteer Tea on June 13<sup>th</sup> from 2 pm organized by the school staff for all the parents who have volunteered and helped the school during this school year. Invitations were sent out by the teachers.
- Thank you, PAC, for organizing the Appreciation lunch for all school staff on June 2<sup>nd</sup>.

## 2. Approval of the April PAC Meeting Minutes

Michelle made a motion to approve the <u>April PAC Meeting Minutes</u>, Katerina seconded the motion. PAC voted and Minutes were approved. Motion passed.

## 3. Choir surplus fund vote

Trafalgar junior and senior choir at Trafalgar was organized by DPAC Music Working group who run the Extracurricular Choral Program at many schools in the district. The working group has requested to dissolve the Choral program so they could create a non-profit society called "Vancouver Extracurricular Music Society (VEMS)" to continue the program independently from DPAC. The Vancouver DPAC welcomed this change and the motion to dissolve the Choral program passed at the April DPAC Executive Meeting.

The DPAC Executive declared surplus funds from the DPAC Choral program, and the motion was passed at the May DPAC Executive Meeting to disburse the funds at the direction of each PAC participating in the program. The surplus funds allotted to Trafalgar is expected to be \$ 3,224.74 (please note that there may be a change in the exact amount due to possible unexpected costs over the last few weeks).

Votes will be taken now to either have the allocation of the funds for Trafalgar returned to the PAC or donate to VEMS.

Votes were taken and the majority voted for the surplus funds to be returned to Trafalgar PAC.

## 4. Special AGM segment

- The PAC thanked the leaving members, Shervin, Kathy, Katerina and Sean.
- The PAC introduced one new executive member, Sophia, who accepted to be the treasurer (French Immersion) in the 2023/2024 school year.
- The PAC informed that there are available positions for French immersion Co-Chair and two secretaries.

### 5. 2023/2024 PAC Big Budget

2022/2023 Treasurer's Report presented by Kathy:

- Total revenue \$ 76,272
- Total Expenses \$ 40,185
- Projected total to carry over for next year \$ 82,434.

The 2023/2024 proposed budget presented by Kathy was created based on the consultation with parent budget survey and teachers wish list. New items in the budget include knitting club, cooking lessons, and new jerseys. New items from the teacher's wish list which the PAC will vote on include 4x stationary bikes, large TV screen and bike cage. The proposed budget is \$ 71,948 before voting.

Voting:

- IDEA budget voting on the removal of \$ 1,000 budget line due to no IDEA activities this year. Cristina Aydin, a member of the IDEA Committee, informed the PAC that the committee could not organize any events this year, but was active and asked to keep the budget line for next school year. Votes were taken and 57% voted to keep the IDEA budget line.
- Spirit Wear voting on the buy out of the inventory of \$ 1,274. Votes were taken and 93% voted to buy out the spirit wear inventory.
- Stationary bikes school has asked for 4x stationary bikes in the amount of around \$4,000. Votes were taken and 71% voted to fund the bikes.
- Bike racks school has asked for bike racks in the amount of around \$7,000. Votes were taken and 57% voted to fund the bike racks.

• Large TV screen – school has asked for a large TV screen to be installed in the school hall in the amount of around \$ 2,500. Votes were taken and 64% voted to fund the TV screen.

The proposed big budget for the 2023/2024 school year is \$ 86,448 after voting. Kathy made a motion to approve the budget, Katerina seconded. Votes were taken and the big budget was approved. Motion passed.

#### 6. Year End Party

Alison Scarlett, the year end party organizer, informed the PAC that the event planning is ongoing. There are already a lot of meal pre-orders. There will be entertainment, bubbles, a dance motivator, ice cream, pop corn. Balls available for kids to play with.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:25 pm.

DPAC执行部门宣布了来自DPAC合唱计划的盈余资金,并在5月的DPAC执行会议上通 过了该动议,即在参与该计划的每个政治行动委员会的指示下支付这些资金。 分 配给Trafaglar的盈余资金预计为3,224.74美元(请注意,由于过去几周可能发生的意外成本,确切数额发生了变化)。

现在将投票决定将Trafaglar 的资金分配归还给PAC或捐赠给VEMS。

投票通过后, 多数人投票赞成将剩余资金返还给Trafaglar PAC。

#### 5.2023/2024 PAC 大的 预算

Kathy提交的2022/2023年财务报告:

总收入为76,272美元

总费用为40,185美元

Kathy提出的2023/2024年预算提案是根据与家长预算调查和教师愿望清单的协商 而制定的。预算中的新项目包括针织俱乐部, 烹饪课程, 新运动衫。PAC将投票表 决的教师愿望清单中的新项目包括4倍固定自行车、电视大屏幕和自

行车篷。

投票前的预算为71,948美元。

投票:

- IDEA预算—— 由于今年没有IDEA活动,投票决定取消1000美元的预算项目。 IDEA的成员克里斯蒂娜·艾丁通知PAC,该委员会今年不能 组织任何活动 ,但她很活跃,并要求保留下一学年的预算。投票结果显示,57%的人投 票支持保留这一预算理念。
- 学校文化衫 —-\_投票决定购买1274美元的库存。投票结果显示, 93%的人投 票否决了学校文化衫库存。
- 固定自行车——学校要求4倍固定自行车约4000美元。投票后,71%的人投票 赞成资助这些自行车。
- 自行车架——学校已经要求购买大约7000美元的自行车架。投票后, 57%的 人投票 赞成资助自行车架。
- 大屏幕屏幕——学校要求在学校大厅里安装一个大屏幕,安装金额约为2500 元。投票后,64%的人投票资助电视屏幕。

投票后, 2023/2024学年的巨额预算为86,448美元。Kathy提出了批准预算的动议, Katerina 附议。投票获得通过, 大预算获得通过。活动通过了。
