Since its launch, we have had over 350 local families fill out our form seeking assistance for food. Many of these families have between four and seven members. We have partnered with **DeliverEnd**, a company that allows everyday drivers to sign up and help ensure the necessary food and supplies get to our families. This allows those in need to stay at home, reducing the chances of being infected with COVID-19. With many left unemployed during this pandemic, we have allowed people the chance to earn extra money by joining the Plug Eats movement and helping deliver items to those in need.

Plug Eats will continue to run throughout this epidemic and will serve all those in need of food and supplies.





## Ways that you can help:

- 1. **Financial contribution** Despite financial uncertainty during this time; no donation is too small as every dollar goes directly to the families affected by the epidemic. Donations can be sent through our GoFundMe page.

- 5. **Vehicles for temporary use** Vehicle will be used at your convenience

- 7. **Freezer space** Adequate space to store food for distribution
- 8. **Portable freezers** Room to store frozen food (both day to day and on the way to deliver)
- 9. **PPE** (personal protection equipment) Both for prep and deliver
