4. **Owen (from Peters (Cornell) feedback):** I continue to try and find a use case for searching content that my institution has not acquired. If I'm interested discovering the content in a resource, why would I not go to the vendor for that information? In what case would I go to a knowledgebase of some sort? Of course I could do a Overlap Analysis, and I believe that's a very useful application, but that's a separate task from searching for content that we haven't acquired. And the world of content that I *can't* access is so many times larger than the content that I *can* access -- and probably more so for others. I just see no reason to want to search content we can't access. - issue shall be discussed in a future meeting

Current sprint update (Owen)

- Sprint 57: basic license creating and editing
- search licenses
- adding terms to licenses
- adding organisations to licenses
- new story to support for open ended licenses
- set of default terms for a license always in display; terms that will always be displayed in the section without being filled
- not limited to alphabetical display; default order possible
- configurable per tenant
- licensor included to license information section
- not in Sprint 57: icons for term values and notes for term values

- for further discussion: support for “renewal” of a license
- interaction between license and agreement start and end dates

Review of key ERM concepts (Owen)
