Overview

This performance task gives you the opportunity to research your chosen member and gain an understanding of what others do in the USAF/USSF and how everyone contributes to mission accomplishment.

Details

- 1. Identify an enlisted member that you know to brief their USAF/USSF story as related to Airmanship. This can be a past supervisor, co-worker, subordinate or someone you admire. Historical figures will not be used for this assignment.
- 2. After you have selected the individual you will brief about, communicate with your flight and instructor to ensure no two individuals select the same person.
- 4. Consider what you have learned about the Profession of Arms, Warrior Ethos, and Progressive Professionalism when preparing your presentation. Some additional items to consider are:
- What it means to be a professional
- What it means to be an effective leader and manager
- Member's contribution to the team
- How mission accomplishment depends on a network of Air and Space Professionals.
- 5. Once these questions are answered, you will put together a presentation, using a style of your choosing, displaying the things you learned about your chosen Air or Space Professional. This product could be a PowerPoint, story board, or any other presentation format desired.

Note: You must create a product, however, those products will not be evaluated or influence the rubric in any way. You will display the following items:

- The member's role in the Air or Space Force, describing their duties and responsibilities that align with their role.
- Their level of professionalism by how the member embodied the Profession of Arms.
- Their contribution to the team by how the member's actions, decisions and behaviors contributed to a specific event in their career.
- 6. Finally, the delivery portion will have certain guidelines, such as:
- Demonstrate professionalism and appropriate language.
- Presentation delivery must be within 5-7 minutes.
- Visual aids are required. (Product will not influence the rubric in any way).
