<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Accurate: Is the content presented free of error, free of bias, or outdated material that could confuse or mislead students. 			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Adequate: Is the content provided addressing the intended standards/learning goals and/or integrating other subjects? 			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Appropriate: Is the content appropriate for the target audience? 			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Availability: Is this a digital resource or an OER?

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Appropriate: Does the use of the technology relate to standards? 			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Appropriate: Does the use of technology deepen learning and increase engagement? SAMR 			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Accessible: Does the technology work on the intended device and are any add-ons needed (software, plug ins, etc.) 			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Accessible: Does technology support accommodations for learners with cognitive, developmental, or physical disabilities? 			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Accessible: Does the resource require a student account or login? 			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Accessible: Can the resource be accessed offline? How will students without internet access utilize the resource outside of school if needed?

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Motivating: Does the resource address standards in an engaging way for the target audience? 			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> User-Friendly: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Student: Is the resource easy to use with the targeted audience? Teacher: Is the resource easy for the teacher to understand and support student use?
